Strict regulations were announced to guard the grain crop against theft and waste. Local authorities throughout the Soviet Union were warned to make no alteration in plans outlined by the Central Committee.

Peasants and collective farms had been permitted since the beginning of 1933 to make private sales of surpluses remaining after the government collection plan was fuffiled.

The Central Committee's edict expressed the opinion the harvest this year-would equal that in 1933, in spite of a drought in some sections, and warned officials of collective and state farms that they must not make weather conditions and excuse for laxity in harvesting crops.

The committee announced state farms must supply 70,000,000 bushels to the government.
