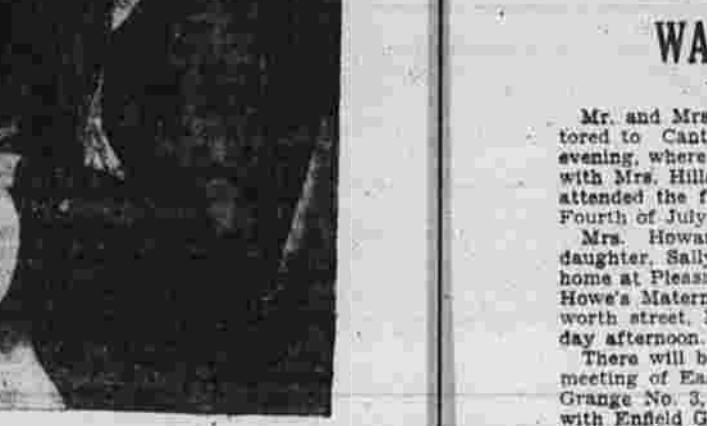
Woman who was struck by the Chevrolet car, was taken from the scene to a Springfield hospital...



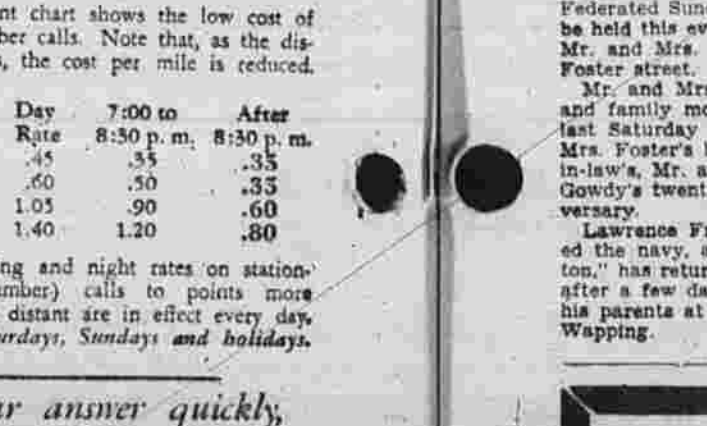
Driver of the Chevrolet car, which the state police learned today, was killed.



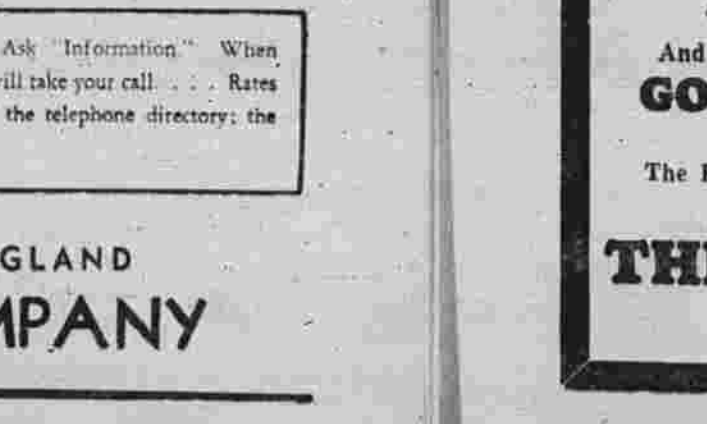
Driver of the other car was taken to a hospital in Bolton.
