POST OFFICE IS OUT OF THE RED FARLEY STATES Income Exceeds Expenses by \$5,000; First Year Without Deficit Since 1919, 7th in Half Century

Washington, July 21.—Postmaster General Farley has informed President Roosevelt that a long-sought goal of the Postoffice Department, a balanced budget, has been achieved.

In a radio message to the President aboard the cruiser Houston Mr. Farley declared that pre-audited figures for the fiscal year ended June 30 showed that postal receipts for the first time since 1919 had exceeded expenditures by the amount of \$5,000,000.

Mr. Farley's reply to Mr. Roosevelt read: "I am delighted to have your report that the Postoffice Department will have a surplus of approximately \$5,000,000 for the fiscal year 1919 but such a result has not been accomplished, and this notwithstanding a reduction in postage on local letters and charges against the other revenues never before included in the cost of postal service."

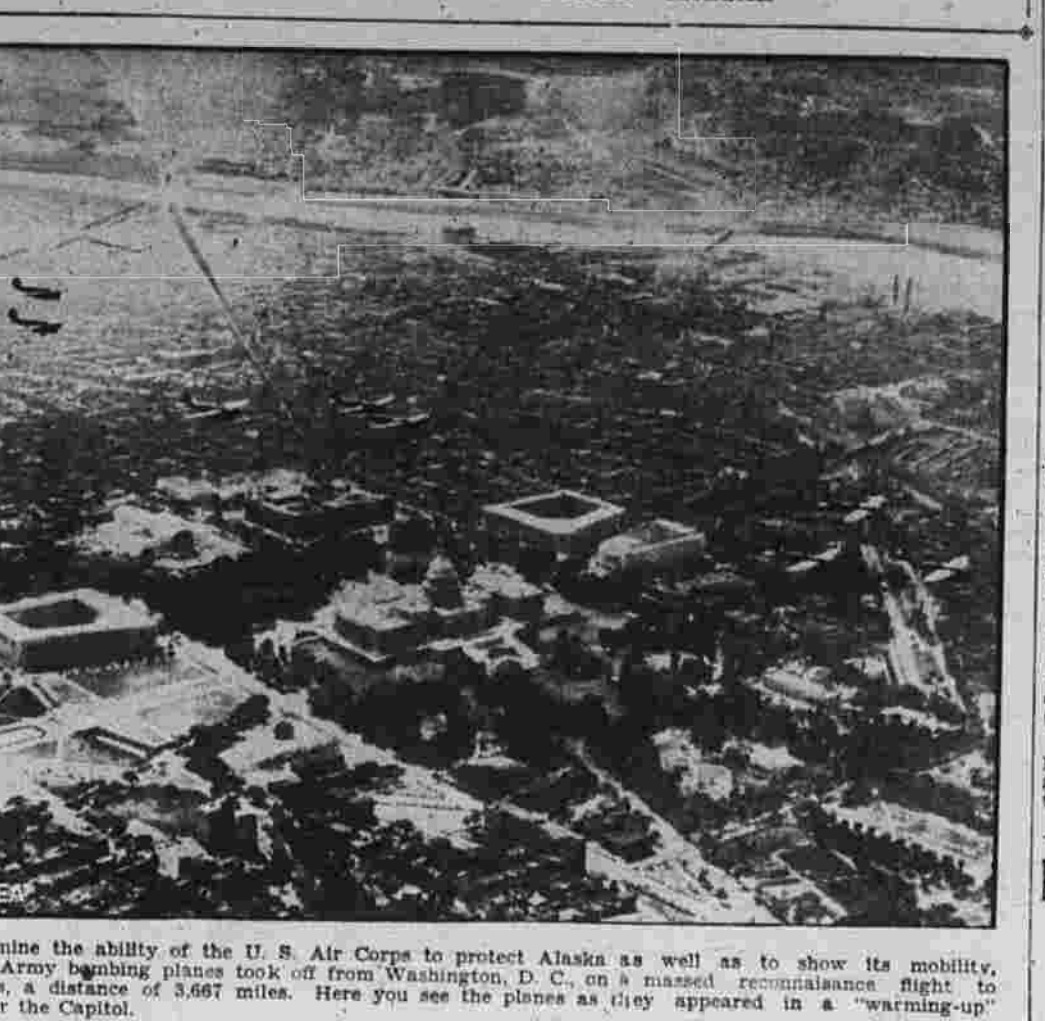
