

### KEENE THREATENED BY A \$300,000 FIRE

#### New Hampshire City Suffers Big Loss by Blaze; Million Cartridges Are Exploded by the Heat.

Keene, N. H., Aug. 18.—(AP)—Nearly a million rounds of ammunition were exploded and fifteen persons driven to the street today in a general alarm fire that threatened the entire business section of the city and that destroyed the Lane block. Damage was estimated by Fire Chief Eugene B. Riley as in excess of \$300,000.

The ammunition was on the second floor of the Spencer Hardware company, and despite the frantic efforts of firemen to douse it with water, it exploded when the flames reached it. Almost miraculously, authorities said, no one was struck as the nearly a million cartridges were discharged.

Firemen were overcome by smoke and ammonia fumes from an air-cooling system in the basement of the block. An elderly woman and a deaf man were rescued from their third floor apartments. Chief Riley said the blaze apparently was caused by spontaneous combustion in the basement. The flames spread rapidly and swept through the W. L. Goodwin department store, the largest in the city, and into Quernsey Iron, Inc., a food and grocery establishment.

The block housed, besides the stores, apartments occupied by 25 persons on the two top floors of the four story brick building but only about 20 were home at the time of the fire, which began shortly before midnight and was not brought under control until after 4:00 a. m.

### REPORT VACCINE FOR PARALYSIS

#### Professor Says Serum from Monkeys Will Immunize Children; Used It Himself.

Philadelphia, Aug. 18.—Development of a successful method for vaccinating human beings to immunize them against infantile paralysis was asserted here today.

Dr. John A. Klomer, Professor of Medicine at Temple University and director of the Research Institute of Outaneous Medicine of Philadelphia, his co-researcher, reported today that he had immunized himself and his children with a vaccine made from the serum of three years of experimental work which he had conducted on children and which he had successfully immunized and that a way has been found for the prevention of epidemics of acute anterior poliomyelitis.

The vaccine developed by Dr. Klomer and his technical assistant, Miss Anne M. Ruit, the research institute was tried last year, and this year on monkeys, and the experiments were continued until the results became almost 100 per cent successful, he said.

A few months ago Dr. Klomer and his aide vaccinated themselves and experienced no reactions. "I've caught slight soreness at the site of the injection," Dr. Klomer said he probably would vaccinate his own two children and he predicted that eventually vaccine against infantile paralysis would be a routine matter in infancy or childhood, just as immunization against measles and diphtheria has become.

The vaccine is prepared from the spinal cords of monkeys. After the disease has been induced artificially in the animal, it is treated with sodium dichromate, which is oxidizing to the color brown. According to Dr. Klomer, this chemical does not kill the virus but devitalizes it.

"All mice vaccinated with monkeys with a completely killed or devitalized virus have hereafter failed," he said. "Apparently the vaccine must contain a small amount of devitalized but living virus to be effective.

"The vaccine, therefore, is something similar to that originally prepared by Pasteur from the spinal cords of rabbits for vaccination against hydrophobia, or rabies, in that Pasteur's vaccine likewise contained small amounts of the living virus, although the poliomyelitis vaccine is differently prepared.

"The vaccine is given by injection under the skin like typhoid, diphtheria and rabies vaccines. It is believed that three doses at weekly intervals are sufficient.

More than forty monkeys have been used during the last two years in the experiments. Last year the results were from 30 to 40 per cent successful with the doubling of the vaccine's strength. Dr. Klomer said he found that the monkeys were made immune to virtually every case.

### LEGISLATOR BACKS LONG; MAKES HIM A DICTATOR

#### Reporters Excluded from House, Camera Man Slugged and Fist Fights Feature of the Session.

Baton Rouge, La., Aug. 18.—(AP)—The Huey P. Long machine today held the broadest powers of military and political control ever conferred on a single action in Louisiana.
