

STATE G. O. P. PICKS DELEGATES TONIGHT

Unusual Interest This Year in the Caucuses to Be Held in Nearly Every Town—Some of the Candidates.

By ASSOCIATED PRESS. The Republicans of Connecticut, today are going to do what the Democrats have already done—select delegates to the party convention, which as a sum total, will name the ticket to be voted for at the November election.

It is many years since there has been such an apparent stir in the Republican party over caucus selection of delegates as will be evident in a large number of the 168 towns. Not all towns hold a caucus but most of them do. In the large majority, proceedings will slip through with scarcely a ripple.

But in some others the rivalries may prove that Governor Wilbur L. Cross was no prophet when he recently said the Republicans kept their troubles under cover. It looked in advance of caucus openings that in some places, the Republicans were going into a "ding out" fight.

Will Open Race. The selection of delegates to the convention at Hartford, September 10 and 11, will have first place in the caucuses as a whole, because of the availability of so many men for the gubernatorial nomination and the recent comment of State Chairman J. Henry Borsback that the race "was an open one."
