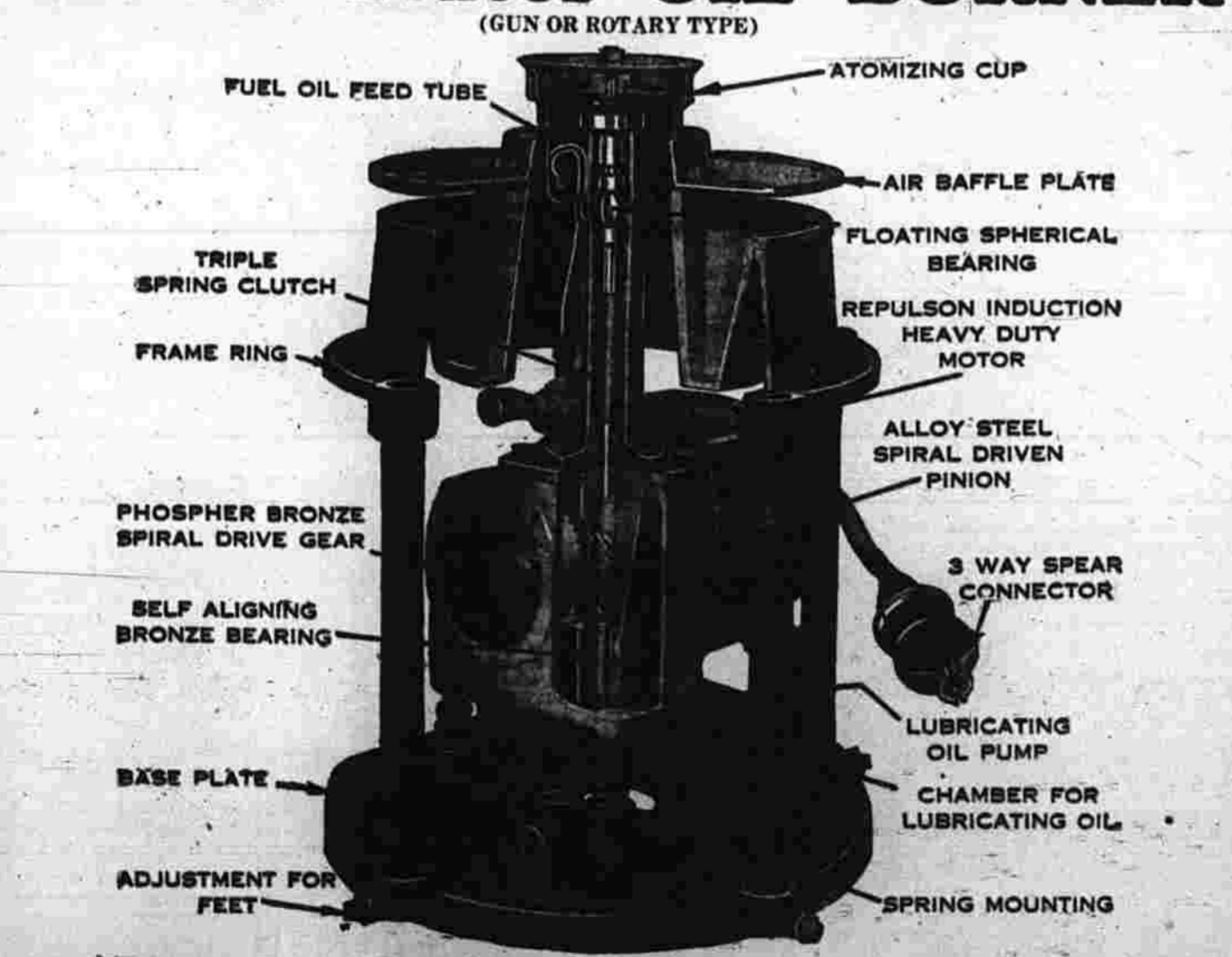

MORTGAGE BANKING SYSTEM ORGANIZED To Finance Home Loans Private Capital Is Made Available. The National Housing Act authorizes the organization of new institutions by private capital, to be known as National Mortgage Associations,

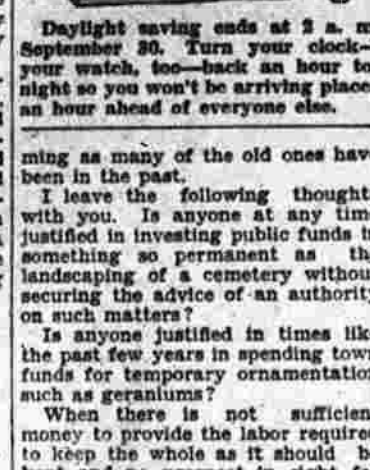
