CHENEY PERSONNEL CHANGE ANNOUNCED

Reduction of Demands in Broad Goods, Velvet and Throwing Departments Necessitate Retirement of Senior Officers of Firm, Official Statement Issued Today, Says.

Official announcement of a reorganization of the executive personnel of Cheney Brothers, calling for the retirement of Messrs. William C. Cheney, Horace B. Cheney, Howell Cheney and Charles Herman Cheney, who are the senior in point of service, was made today.

In a statement to The Evening Herald, the firm stated that the action was necessary to "bring about a reduction in the production schedules of the broad goods, velvet and throwing departments to bring them within the reduced demands for goods now prevailing."

According to the returns of officials and directors of Cheney Brothers filed with the secretary of state as of July 1, 1934, only one name of Cheney appears on the Board of Directors. The others are officers of banks in Boston and New York with which the firm has had financial dealings.

Officers listed in the report follow: President, Ward Cheney, Locust Valley, N. Y.; first vice-president, Robert Cheney, South Manchester; second vice-president, Horace B. Cheney; secretary, Howell Cheney; treasurer, Louis S. Carter; assistant treasurer, Clifford D. Cheney; assistant secretary, Louis S. Carter. The directors are Morgan B. Brainard, care of Acton Insurance Company, Hartford; Ward Cheney, John F. McGuire, care of Fidelity Bankers Company, New York; Louis S. Carter, Charles S. Miller, care of First National Bank, Boston, Mass.; John P. Grinnon, care of Bankers Trust Company, New York.

Mr. Carter also will retire, and treasurer and further reductions are to be made in other subordinate and executive positions.

SIMON LAKE LAUNCHES NEW TREASURE HUNTER

Veteran Inventor Has Submarine Ready to Wrest Untold Wealth from Bottom of Sea.

Stratford, Oct. 6. (AP)—A strange craft, designed to wrest from Old Neptune untold wealth and timeless treasure, embarked today on a career which its designer, Simon Lake, believes "will open up vast areas of the world to exploitation and expansion of industry in many directions."

The latest nautical child of the veteran inventor, "the submarine salvager," "Lakaco," was to be launched today from the old Housatonic Shipbuilding Company yard.

Lake's plan for scooping wealth from submarine areas does not stop with the "Lakaco." He said if the craft proved practical, he would construct another and attempt to salvage the "Lantern," torpedoed in 1915 off the coast of Ireland and which was in the New York area. In the East river alone lies the wreckage of the British brig "Husar," which is said to have a \$5,000,000 gold cargo.


