



In Sierra Nevada Mountains Snowdrifts Have Blocked the

San Francisco, Nov. 19.—(AP)—
A wind and rain storm which lashed
Northern California was blamed for
at least eight deaths today, while the
Sierra Nevada mountains highway
crews battled huge drifts of snow.
The storm, which centered off the
coast, also was felt in the Pacific
northwest and the far western
plateau region.
In the San Francisco bay area,
where all of the deaths occurred,
the storm uprooted trees, interrupted electric and telephone service
in some sections, choked street
drains and flooded basements of
homes.
Five of the deaths were in automobile accidents, which police said

mobile accidents, which police said were caused by the blinding rain and slippery pavements. Three men drowned in San Francisco bay aft-er a squall swamped their light fish-ing heat mg boat.

More than three feet of snow was reported at Donner Summit. Depths at other mountain points ranged from a foot to three feet.

Chicago, Nov. 19.—(AP) — A scientist's cagerness to speed his experiment with transparent rubber has caused his death.

Dr. Eric von Fuelnegg-Gebauer, 33, died yesterday from the effects of hydroschloric acid in his lungs. He died without learning whether his rubber compound as transparent as glass will be successful—his associates believe it will.

The scientist inhaled hydrogen chloride gas while transferring a quantity of it from one container to another Thursday in a Gary, Ind., iaboratory where he worked in addition to his duties at Northwestern University.
