The total gas sales for the first nine months amounted to 6,506,521,000 cubic feet. The nine-month period witnessed a slight decrease in the volume of domestic sales, but through an increase of 18.2 percent in the use of gas for general house heating and a gain of 7 percent in the industrial and commercial use

of gas. In the month of September alone there was an increase of 36.4 percent in the use of gas for house heating as compared with the same month of the previous year.

There was also a gain of 49.4 percent in the number of customers using gas for general house heating since September, 1933.
