150 PERSONS INJURED AS FLOOR COLLAPSES

500 Men, Women and Children Dropped to Floor Below—Janitor's Quick Wit Saves Many.

Liverpool, England, Dec. 13.—(AP)—A quick thinking janitor was credited today with having averted a major disaster when a collapsing floor dropped nearly 600 persons into a terrified mass 14 feet to the floor below.

The floor collapsed at St. Clements school while school children and their parents were enjoying a concert celebrating the beginning of the Christmas holidays. Approximately 150 were injured, and 33 of them, mostly women and children, were taken to a hospital.
