ASKS TO ENLARGE ARMY IN FRANCE

General Tournes Asserts Germany's Armed Forces Are Increasing Rapidly.

Paris, Dec. 15.—(AP)—A campaign for longer conscript service in the French army was in progress today under the sponsorship of military experts who believe the German army will outnumber the two to one by next April.

Agitation for extension of the present one-year service was suggested by General Tournes and Albert Meunier, unanimously with recommendations by the army committee of the Chamber of Deputies that the 500,000,000 franc emergency military fund be used immediately to arm French troops with latest battle devices.

General Tournes is an artilleryman in Echo de Paris, asserted Germany with only 480,000 men, and 60 shock divisions of 1,200,000 men.

By next April, he wrote, Germany's army will total 600,000 of which half will be conscript and half half-trained Nazi France on the other hand. The article said that only 216,000 troops on its own soil of which all but 60,000 are untrained conscripts of German origin.
