Farmers, people who handle food, particularly milk and the flesh of animals, and all workers in slaughter houses ought to be particularly careful of the disease called undulant fever. It gets its name from the fact that the fever goes up and down in waves.

At the same time, investigators have discovered this germ to human beings in cattle, called brucella abortus. Around 1918, Miss Alice Evans, the United States Public Health Service found that the same germ was responsible for milk fever.
