Easter Brings the Bunny to the Quintuplets' Nest



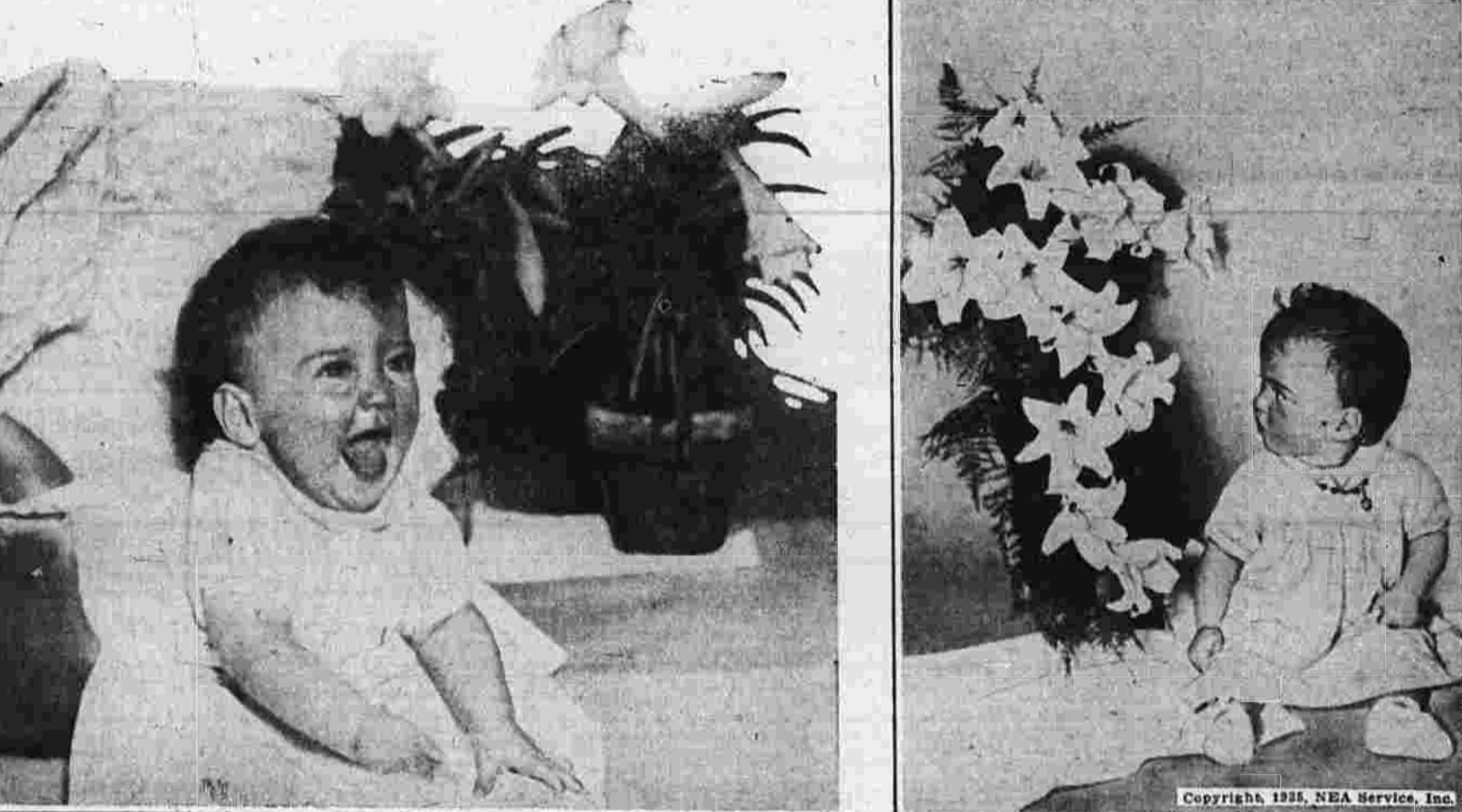

Louisville, Ky., April 29.—(AP)—The fact has heretofore been held as a jinx that no Belmont Futurity winner has ever won the Kentucky Derby. They have been equally persistent about denying Derby victory to a colt bearing the Joseph E. Widener label.

That Chance Sun, handsome brown son of Chance Shot-Bunath, gallops home the winner in the Blue Grass classic, he will hand turf president a double-barreled blast. For he is owned by Widener and won by four lengths in the 1934 Futurity. Trainer Pete Coyne goes about preparing the winter-bred favorite for the Derby by the Wisconsin-Delaware "jinx" for, he concludes, it is not reasonable to believe that a colt boasting the all-around class of Widener should never enjoy a Derby triumph, nor that a steed good enough to win the rich Futurity stakes cannot likewise add the Derby to his conquests.

Trainer is confident
The colt has beaten many of the good ones entered in the Derby and looks great, says Coyne, who recently brought Chance Sun from Widener's Elmendorf farm near Lexington to Louisville.

Particularly will this be true if the track is heavy. In winning the Futurity and also the Grand Union Hotel Stakes at Saratoga, Chance Sun proved himself a superb miler. On that track his performance has not been overly impressive. In his other 11 starts last year the colt won once and was second five times.

Beat His Derby Foes
He opened away to an easy victory at Belmont, gaining fairs and \$7,000. Four months later, he won Bradley's Ballad, in second place, half a length ahead of the Green Tree stable's First Boy. Victory in the Grand Union Hotel Stakes added \$4,000 to his winnings. Since the Futurity, run September 15, the colt has been in retirement.

Chances Sun was the leading money winner two-year-old of 1934, with earnings of \$28,837. He was recalled in this respect only by Cavalotte, last year's Derby winner.
