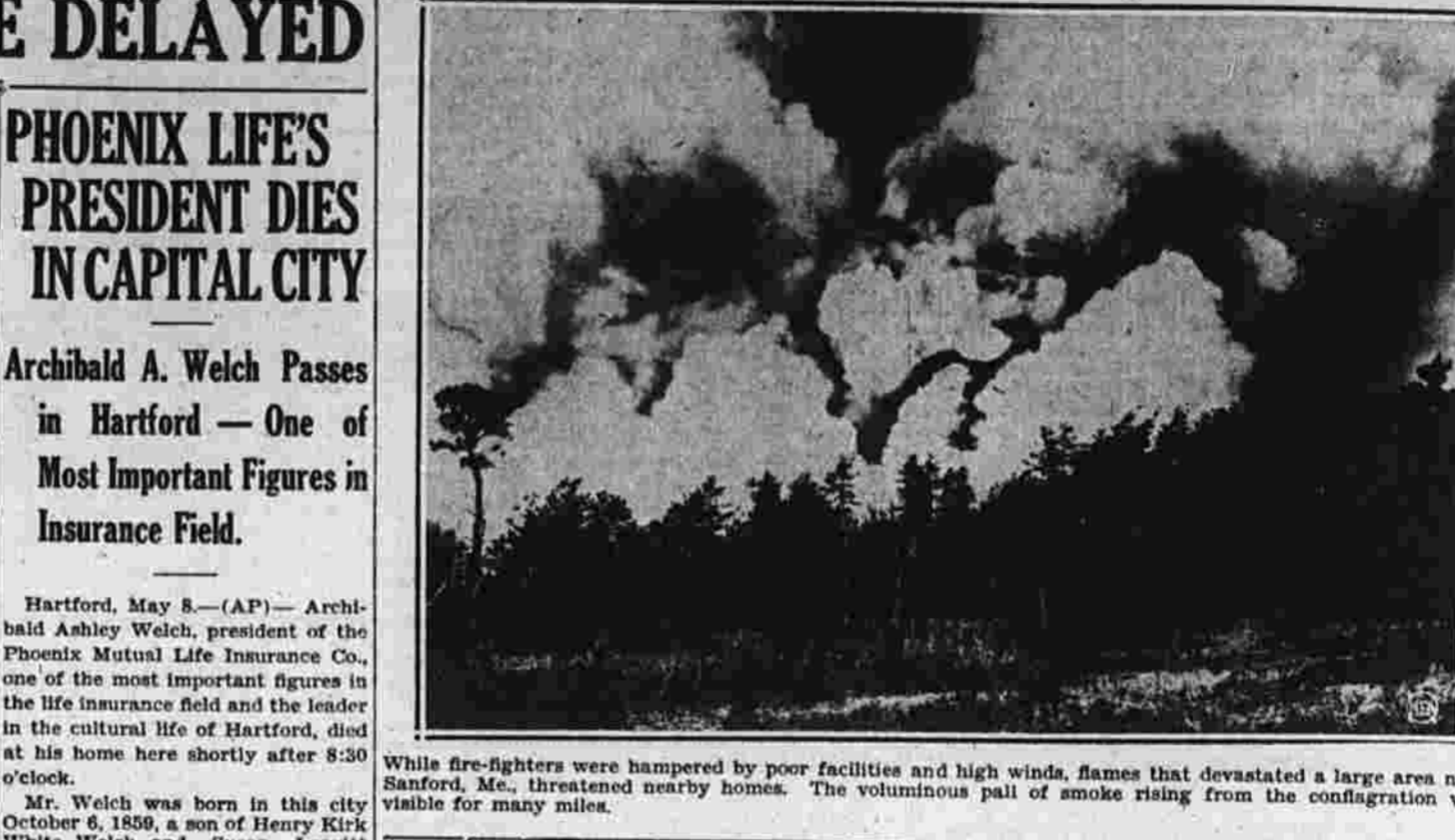

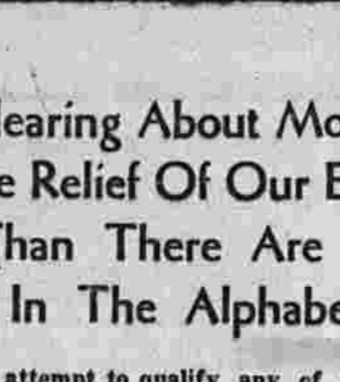
SLAYER EXECUTED

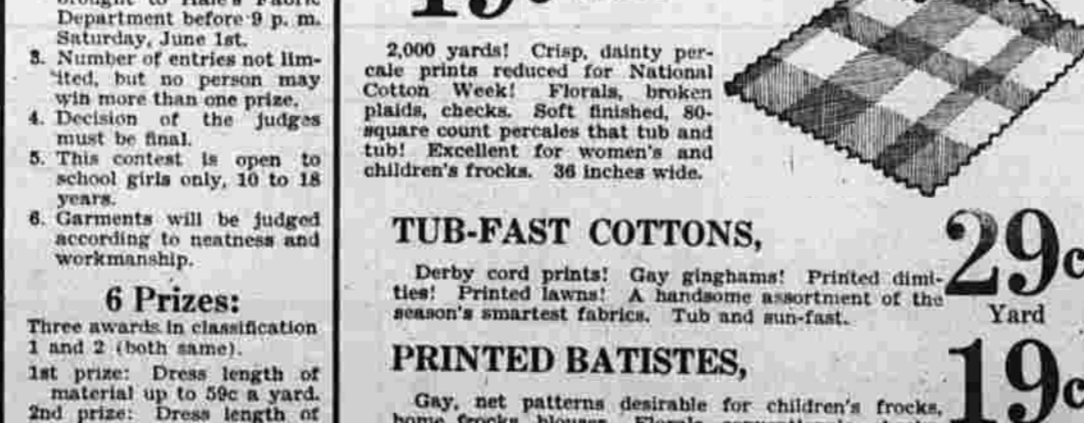
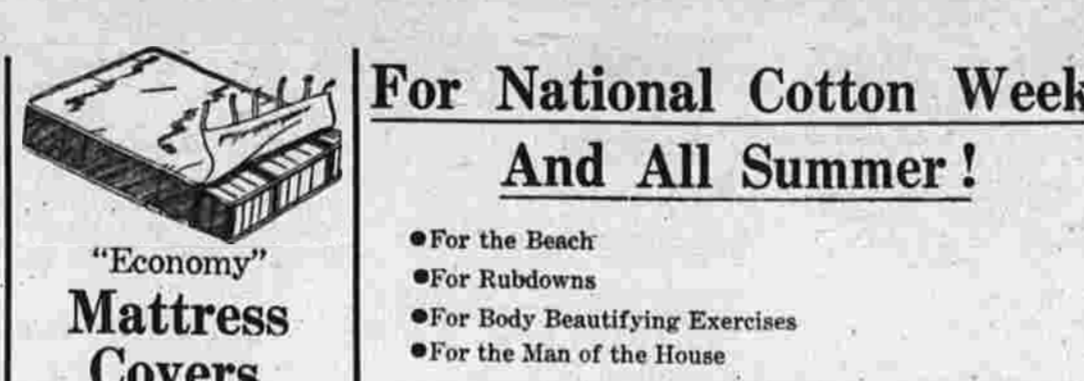
