CAMPBELL TO SEEK NEW SPEED RECORD

Says He Will Try to Reach 300 Miles an Hour at Salt Lake City Next Month.

London, June 5.—(AP)—Sir Malcolm Campbell, British sportsman, will attempt to better his own record by driving a car at 300 miles an hour at Salt Lake City in July, he announced today.

Speaking before an advertising club luncheon gathering, Campbell said he would leave for Utah in July for a new record attempt that month. He lifted the record to 276.816 miles per hour at Daytona Beach March 7.

"It's impossible to rely in the future on the beach if you wish to do anything in the region of 300 miles an hour," the sportsman said. "You must have 100 per cent perfect conditions for high speed. We now are carrying out further tests for our attempt in July."

Although arrangements are far from complete, Sir Malcolm told the Associated Press he was "virtually certain" to make the record attempt before the summer is out.

"My mechanics are going to work on this thing now," he said. "I'll get her in top shape. There may be several slight modifications but no major changes in her construction or motor."

The speed king was enthusiastic about prospects of reaching his goal of 300 miles an hour on the dry lake bed course. He said his present car has had a 13-mile straightaway.

"If I'm going to attain 300 miles an hour before I hang up my goggles," he said, "that looks like the best chance of doing it."

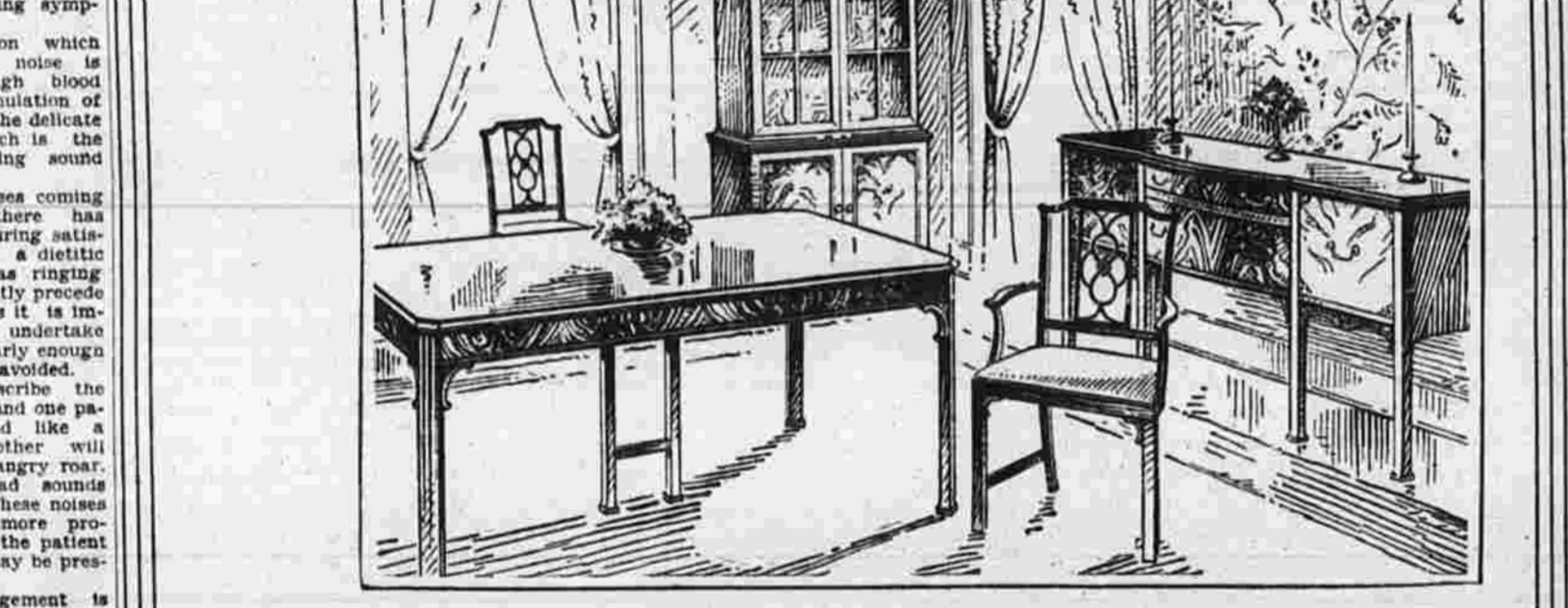
