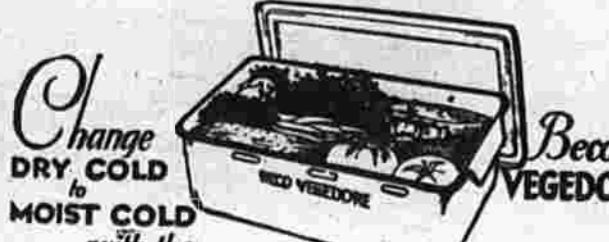

RAVAGES OF ELM BEETLES DECISIVELY SHOWN HERE

Eldridge Street Trees Are Swarming With Destructive Insects—Resident Invites Spraying Opponents To View The Damage.

Residents of Eldridge street are rapidly becoming convinced of the accuracy of predictions made by several scientists that mankind will be eventually driven from the face of the earth by insects.

Yesterday afternoon John H. May of 61 Eldridge street demonstrated the ravages of the elm beetle in his neighborhood and invited his neighbors to view the damage to the elms in a recent town meeting.

Leaving an easy chair on his front porch to greet his visitor, Mr. May's shirt was covered with red and green spots which he had brushed off the evening before.

His home, he said, was alive with insects which crawl over the dining room table and the beds in spite of the fact that he has a vacuum cleaner.

Overhead the leaves of the elm trees already turned brown. Most of them were in the neighborhood of the house and could be seen through the window.

Leaves Drop Off The ground was littered with dead leaves from the elms. Late Saturday afternoon Mr. May reported, the lawn surrounding his home was raked clean.
