ASKS VETERANS TO HELP DRIVE FOR RECOVERY

Gen. Hines Tells Disabled Ex-Service Men That Government Will Provide Jobs for Them.

New Haven, July 18.—(AP)—General Frank T. Hines contending that the welfare of the veteran hinges on the general welfare of the country, expressed confidence today before the National convention of the Disabled Veterans that those who served in the World War to their full part in the drive for National recovery.

In a speech prepared for delivery at the first general session of the National convention of Veterans Affairs held today in New Haven, Gen. Hines said that there would be new opportunities for employment of veterans under the emergency relief administration act of 1933.

"The veterans administration has pledged its cooperation to the government agencies which have been placed the responsibility for making the program effective," he said. "It is our duty to see that its accomplishment should and will result in gainful employment to millions who are now being supported through public relief funds because of no particular fault of their own, but because they have been unable to obtain work."

"Relief to veterans can best be obtained through bringing relief to the country as a whole and the country as a whole can only regain its normal economic position through the status of the approximately fifty million wage earners as a whole. I am sure we can depend upon the veterans doing their full part."

Recalls Marine Battle
 Recalling the Battle of the Marne, Gen. Hines said that today is the turning point of the World War administrator said.

"Conditions have faced us during the past five or six years which have called for the same character and zeal, determination, effort and patriotism to overcome as was required to attain victory in 1918 and the indications are that as the turning point of the war was reached in July, 1918, the turning point of the depression has been reached in July of 1935."

General Hines lauded the efforts of President Roosevelt and Congress in behalf of the veteran saying:

"You must conclude with me in the full realization that the President and Congress are perpetuating that which established principle—that adequate care and benefits will be provided by the National government for those veterans who became disabled through injury or disease while defending the Nation's honor in the World War."

A 15 point legislative program was proposed to the delegates by their National legislative chairman Thomas Kirby. He called on the orators in the following order:
