

Hebron also endured the prevailing oppositions of the period principally the differences expressed by the leading families regarding adherence to the Loyalist Party or to the Patriots. Rev. Samuel Peters was one of the chilef objectors against the impending war with the mother country and expressed his opinions often upon the subject; so often, in fact, and with such vehemence, that the local "Sons of Liberty" made two attacks upon him in August and September, 1774.

On the last occasion, in September, 1774, Dr. Peters was reacued from a coating of tar and feathers by Dr. Pomeroy, the Congregational clergyman, and the intended victim of Colonial wrath decided that England was a much safer place to live and left the country. He remained a pensioner in England until after peace was restored.

HEALTH-DIET ADVICE

CAN BE OVERCOME

In yesterday's article I explained to you some of the causes of excessive gas, and in today's article, I will explain why it is that an improper balance of the digestive juices will also produce gas. The gastric juices of the stomach should contain certain digestive ferments, which will be properly balanced in the healthy person living on a good diet. If too much of certain kinds of food is used, the stomach tries to save the individual's life by changing the digestive juices to meet the imposed requirements. For example, if an excess of meat is taken each day, the gastric juice will gradually become more acid. If too many carhohydrates are used, the result will be the excessive formation of bile; if both too much meet and too much starch are used, there will be an excess of both hydrochloric acid and bile. This mixture is one of the most potent and most common causes of fatulence.

Answer: During the warm weather, the children instinctively crave cooling foods, such as watermelon. Allow them to use all they want as a




