Washington, Aug. 24.—(AP)—A Congress adjured by nearly eight months of struggle drew on its last ounces of energy today to whirl feverishly through a vast mass of last-minute legislation and adjournment tonight.

Broken deadlocks and eleventh-hour agreements by legislators long at odds prompted leaders to declare that this was the last day of the 74th Congress.

There seems little doubt, said Speaker Bryan, "that we will be out here tonight."

Going at a tremendous clip yesterday and last night, legislators passed along to the White House such measures as the Quiffy Coal Control bill, the Fraxton-Lentz farm wage memorandum, and an employer-employee dispute resolution bill.
