HOW A SCHOOL MA'AM SLOWED THE BULLIES

A. F. Harlow Gives Glimpses of Turbulent Mountain Institution. By Bruce Catton. When Ella Enlow went down to teach in the one-room school at Shady Cove, Tenn., she ran into a situation right out of the old-time novels - one of those country schools where "boys" or "girls" or "defy the schoolma'am, break the windows, throw dead cats on teacher's desk and in general try to see if they can't run the luckless lady out of the neighborhood. She talks about the experience, in collaboration with Alvin P. Harlow, in "Schoolhouse in the Foothills." It makes a remarkably interesting book. Before she could settle down to teach school, she had to show the boys who was boss. She did this by whipping a strapping six-footer with a switch which she made him out for her. A little later she socked a drunken school-ard and accidentally pushed him out of a porch. He hit his head, went out cold - and the whole community was awed by her prowess, so that after that she had no trouble. Her story is a humbly cross-section of life in an incredibly poverty-stricken section of the South. It is a story of a woman, a lady, beautiful and conductor of funerals, all in one person, and her books are full of touching little "human interest" stories that don't exist now. The TV's armor put that whole valley under many feet of water, re-locating all the inhabitants on new farms, and some of her best pages tell of the impact of this vast program on the sturdy mountaineers.
