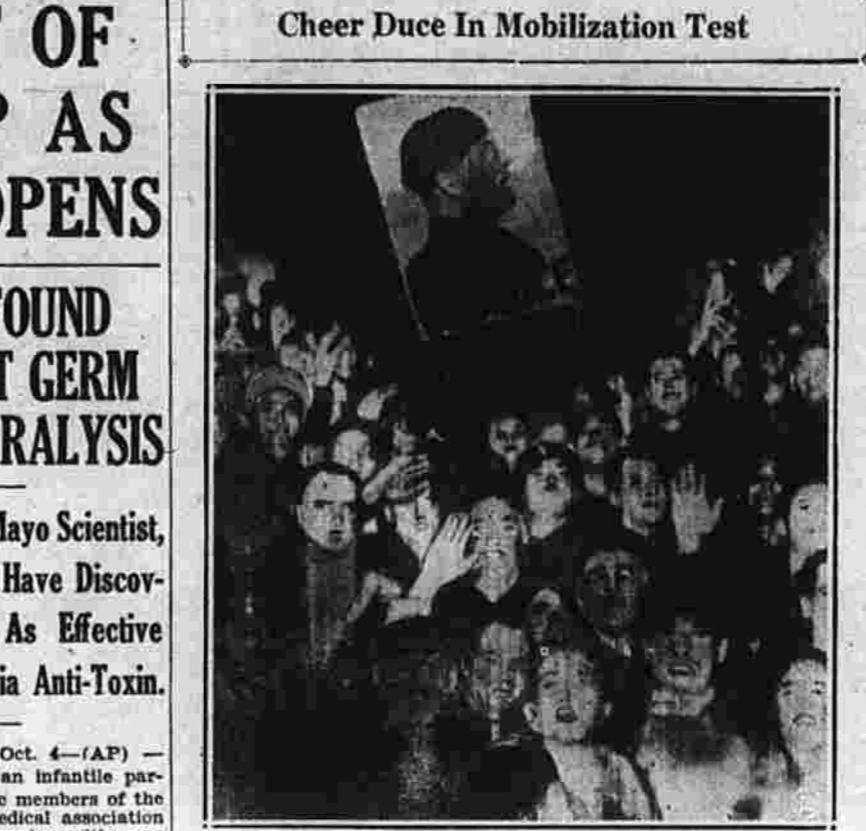

Rosenow of the Mayo Foundation, University of Minnesota, conducted the demonstration, using germ cultures obtained from the spinal fluid of a child with the disease.

Amara, Ethiopia, Oct. 4.—(AP)—Italian troops declared this evening that the fall of Adowa, "Verdun of Ethiopia," was imminent; that bombing planes and tanks were inflicting heavy losses on the Ethiopians. The Italian column had advanced to the hills ten miles away, commanding the plain in which the city is situated.

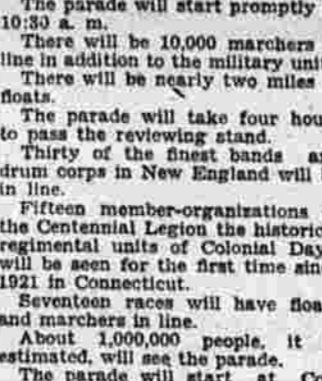
