Cheyenne, Wyo., Oct. 7.—(AP)—Twelve persons aboard an eastbound United Air Lines mail plane crashed to their death about 15 miles west of Cheyenne early this morning.

SESSION IS HELD BY SUPREME COURT No Ceremony as Justice File Into New 11 Million Dollar Building Today.

Washington, Oct. 7.—(AP)—A brief session of the Supreme Court today started the Supreme Court on its new eight months term expected to adjourn in a hearing on whether a constitutional amendment is sought to enlarge Federal powers over commerce.

Assembling for the first time in its \$11,000,000 palatial edifice—the first home of its own in 140 years—the court received a few motions, and admitted more than 100 attorneys to the court and adjourned until noon Monday. Then the real work will begin.

Hours before the noon convening time, persons were lined up waiting the chance to enter the chamber which were able to get in.

The justices put on robes in the chamber at the rear of the court, having entered the building through a private garage, and reached the court in the main hall at 12:30. From the crowd in the old days in the Capitol building, it was necessary to enter the chamber through the throngs which filled the hall.

Headed by Marshal Green, the members—with Justice Hughes presiding—entered the chamber through a heavy blue curtain at the rear of the building. The group of three, went into the hall, all in the court room. The court room is a large hall with a high ceiling, and the seats and the audience look toward the judge's bench.

Members of the families of the justices occupied reserved seats in the room, while in the audience many persons prominent in Washington official circles were present.
