BONUS 'BOOM' DUE TO START NEXT CONGRESS

Washington — Politicians and observers in Washington expect the first ten days of the coming session of congress to culminate any statistics for any congress in recent times.

They base their expectations on a simple but politically powerful word spelled "BONUS".

Dread Disease of Eye Is Conquered by Science

Washington, Oct. 30.—(AP)—Ten years observation of a treatment by instituted among allied mountain folk in Kentucky, Michigan and Tennessee has convinced Dr. John McMillan of the United States Public Health Service that the "backbone" of the dreaded disease—trachoma—has been broken.

Sitting in his sun-drenched office, Dr. McMillan told of the fight he made from 1912 to 1924 to combat the disease that blinded hundreds of poor hill people before he recognized it as a "surgical" problem necessitating weeks of post-operative care.

Trachoma is an eye disease. It is a form of inflammation of the lids which, if not checked, affects the eyeball and causes blindness.
