whose sole forte heretofore was line plunging.
The full today must carry weight on a long,
rangy frame, and must be able to run with the
fastest halfbacks so that he can get out in the
open and grab laterals and forwards. A fast fullback, too, generally is a better ground gainer
through the line, for he can pick holes better.

In hitting the line, the fullback lowers either
shoulder, and runs low. On mediting tackler, he
raises the shoulder, showing tackler to one side.
Once in the clear, he must be fast enough to
cut back and pick up interference.

On defense, the fullback is a busy man. He
analyzes plays, and at all times must pile into
the heart of the attack as it is simed at the line.
