## BIG NAVAL POWERS REJECT JAP DEMAND

British Dominions Join Italy, France, U. S. and Britain at London Parley—Tokyo Asks Parity.

London, Dec. 12.—(AP)—Japan's demand for equality in naval armaments was rejected at the International Naval Conference today by the four other great naval powers.

American, British and Italian delegates rejected the Japanese proposal, and the support of the British Dominions, which was announced at the first meeting on grounds of procedure.

A judicial committee the Japanese took the lead in opposing the British demand.

The meeting broke up at noon, with the Japanese insisting on their full rights.

Well-informed sources said, however, that the Japanese are submitting certain questions to Tokyo, French and British officials.

Japanese equally well informed sources said that they are waiting for the Japanese to make a counter proposal.

Norman H. Davis, chairman of the United States delegation, in opposition to Japan's proposal, revived around the main points:

1. Adoption of the plan would mean the destruction of the fleet.

2. The proposal did not take into account the different naval needs of the powers.

3. It would upset the equilibrium established by the Washington and London treaties.

4. The United States felt no change had occurred in the international situation which was sufficient to warrant a naval change.

The French emphasized their objection to the Japanese demands as based on the grounds that the powers should have a voice beyond the general agreement, if they declared derelict.

They asserted they were excluded from previous consideration when the limitation treaties were drafted.

Informed persons said the conference would resume sessions tomorrow, when discussion along the same lines would continue and the matter would answer numerous questions.

Washington, Dec. 12.—(AP)—Cities Service today denied charges that it had been guilty of a "preposterous and false" manipulation of the stock market to fix prices.

## ECONOMIC COUNCIL CALLED NECESSARY

Noted Catholic Educator Criticizes Both the New Dealers and Their Foes.

Washington, Dec. 12.—(AP)—The Rev. Edmund A. Walsh, vice-president of Georgetown University, proposed a two-point program which he calls necessary to save the United States from Communism or a dictatorship from the Right.

Father Walsh, prominent Catholic educator, suggests:

Creation of an economic council of which industry, labor and consumers should cooperate in voluntary regulation, with the government retaining the right of enforcement.

Creation of "labor shares," certificates which would entitle workers, over and above their wages, to a share in the profits of the company.

In a speech last night he criticized the New Deal and the right wing, intimating that the latter were responsible for the "troubled" condition of the country.

He compared New Dealers to a fire company which devoted part of its energy to preventing blueprints of the "future labor structure" from being burned.

"As the president has farwelled," he said, "the Roosevelt administration on the expiration of his term, let us hope that the right wing, he said, 'the right wing industry-corporate complex' will be able to take the ball in this breathing spell before the Roosevelt administration can do before the next election."

"For the President is up for election—not business—and he doesn't intend to stay in office," he said, "he is caught with this hot potato."

He said the "right wing" is a "belief that industrial has not provided either sufficiency or security for the masses."
