PRESIDENT BUSY WITH HIS MESSAGE

Also Working on 1937 Budget; May Deliver the Message in Person.

Chicago, Dec. 27.—(AP)—The President's busy day today was apparently made better by a number of telephone calls from his constituents.

This information showed up today in a study of the needs and attitudes of all passengers made by a "ground school" where the stewardesses are taught applied psychology, some home economics and aviation regulations.

BOY'S BOOK REVIEWS EARN HIS FREEDOM

New York Judge Releases Youngster Who Killed "Ugly" Mate—His Name Not Disclosed.

New York, Dec. 27.—(AP)—A 15-year-old boy accused of having killed a playmate, owed his freedom today to a sympathetic judge and book reviews of four classics.

Justice Jacob Parkes, abiding the boy in anonymity, discharged him yesterday with the hope that he would see this boy made a member of the bar, or maybe follow the footsteps of his relative, wearing the cloth of his church, maybe in the footsteps of his father, an engineer.

"I do know that, no matter what the judge says, he will excel in his profession he chooses, he will excel in it," Judge Parkes said.

The judge said that he made no finding when the boy came before him in Bronx Children's Court last June "because I was unable to make a finding. I had to know the boy's background... his environment... his reactions. I had to know his soul, delve into his spirit."

The boy's four book reviews—Charles Reade's "It's Never Too Late to Mend," George Eliot's "Adam Bede" and Mark Twain's "A Connecticut Yankee in King Arthur's Court"—prompted the judge's observation that assignments of books to juvenile delinquents served only to reveal character but also to mould it.

The youth, after a heart-to-heart talk with the judge, left smiling with "Looking Backward" by Edward Bellamy and Paul De Kruif's "Microbe Hunters," volunteering two more, unselected reviews. The first four books had been assigned by the court.
