RAIN AND SLEET HAMPER TRAVEL

Roads a Glare of Ice So Autos Proceed Slowly; Washed Away Today.

Show that started to fall about 4:30 yesterday afternoon turned to sleet shortly after 6 o'clock. The result that traveling by foot or by automobile was hazardous. As is usual in such cases drivers of automobiles drove at a slow rate of speed that, no accident was reported in Manchester during the six hours that the sleet and rain were sent out to sand the highway.

Rain that started to fall about 7:30 washed away the rock creating a dangerous condition. On the new strip of road in Buckland there was considerable trouble. Six automobiles and a Rockville-Hartford bus were stalled. In order to prevent possible accidents the trucks were sent over Main street from Depot square to the Center street.

One long out of town that were not aided by the state or town trucks travel was almost impossible. One Mr. Mortuary of 313 Center street had to try three different routes before he could reach the town.

Because of the bad traveling the Center Travel Bureau was authorized by the Greyhound office in New York to have a ticket for any point south or west of New York, the roads being closed to travel by the New Jersey motor.

The temperature started to rise after 7 o'clock this morning and a warm rain fell. By 9:30 this morning the roads were washed clear of the sleet and snow and the walking conditions were much improved. Although few people were on the streets at that time the rain continued through the night and this morning with indications that the rain would continue through the day.

Many motorists had difficulty last night in making highway on street intersections after stopping for stop lights while heavy rain and sleet were coated with ice.

In several instances when cars on the road were stopped at a traffic light, the driver of the car in front of them, having stopped at a traffic light, was unable to move forward because of the ice coating the road.

A New England bus, well filled with passengers, left the road near the foot of Andover-Bolton hill just east of Bolton Notch soon after 10 o'clock last night.
