UNDERSTANDING

The Rust brothers of Memphis, may or may not have perfected the mechanical cotton picker for which they have been fighting.

These brothers, as you may recall, announced the other day that their cotton picker is at last in shape to go to town.

"How," they asked, "can our invention bring security and leisure from toil, instead of resulting in starvation and homelessness?"

"They have advanced several ideas. One is to lease the machine instead of selling it, requiring the lessee to maintain a definite minimum wage and maximum hour scale for his workers.

Another is to use part of the machine's profits to set up a social insurance plan for the disabled and the aged, and to develop a program of industrial diversification in the southern cotton belt.

Now these suggestions may be very good or they may be very foolish. The cotton picker itself, for that matter, may fall far short of what the brothers expect it to be.

There is something rather ironic about that term, "labor-saving." Labor is "saved" as we say, when some new technical process is perfected; but it sometimes seems almost as if we should say that it is "lost."

The working man whose reward in butter has been cut out from under him by a whirling contrivance of steel is not likely to be content with something to do when it gets there.

And although our whole society is geared to an ever-increasing use of machines, so that it would be insane for us to try to get back to the old handcraft system, we must realize that this "labor" saved really means the foremost problems of this generation.

This machine age contains more promise for the well-being of mankind, in a purely physical sense, than did any other age in history. If man is mainly to be relieved from drudgery he may at last begin to live as God intended him to live, with his mind and spirit as well as with the muscles of his back.

But he has to go on eating while he is doing this high-toned living. It might be wholesome to pause for a minute or two and consider the case of Otto Stukart, mentioned in the first column.

Twenty-one years ago, when the World War was young and some millions of young men had not yet found the graves for which they were destined, Stukart was a French deserter of Austria.

He was captured and sent to a prison camp far back somewhere in the bloody Russian "east."

The war ground its bloody way down the years, and Stukart stayed in prison. Revolution swept across Russia, the war ended, the house of Hapsburg fell, and its empire was shattered—and still Stukart stayed in that desolate prison camp.

For this particular batch of prisoners had simply been forgotten. Stukart remained in prison, along with his comrades, until last, in the year 1928, somebody remembered them and turned them loose.

So Stukart, finally, after 21 years in prison, made his way back to Vienna and was reunited with his wife and daughter, who had supposed him dead.

Now the point of all this is that this monstrous injustice is just a small sample of the sort of thing that war does to individuals.
