INDUSTRIAL WOE HITS PLAINFIELD

Lively Textile Community Faces Deserted Village Status Due to Trouble.

With the closing of the Lawton Mills in the town of Plainfield, the textile manufacturing community faces a deserted village status due to trouble.

At a time ago as last Christmas, the village and property developed the gross, but most homes of the village, some 2,000 in number. Hundreds of workers from the Lawton Mills, many of whom were textile workers who made up one of Connecticut's most thriving communities.

Then, suddenly and almost without warning, the meaning of the word "strike" loomed ominously. About 200 of the 850 hands in the quarter mile long cotton and rayon mill decided not to accept a wage readjustment program scheduled to go into effect in the mill on January 1st.

Monday, January 6, will long be remembered as an eventful day. A sad, eventful one.

It is no longer the humming village of business but a poignant reminder that only one and one-half miles to the west lies the remains of what was once a busy manufacturing hamlet—Packerville, a deserted village.

Where once Captain Daniel Packard of Mystic had visions of a great factory town that would bear his name, only a grassy grove and a three-story brick mill, gaunt in its emptiness, is all that remains.




