PREFERENCE VOTING Paper may, probably, be some indication on the part of the voters regarding the preference primary vote in Wisconsin on Tuesday which resulted in such an overwhelming majority for the Democratic Roosevelt over Senator Borah.

There was no one for Democrats to vote for, on the preference line, and Roosevelt and his associates delegates other than Roosevelt delegates; there being no contest and the Democrats being of all one mind.

On the other hand, there was a serious fight in the Republican party between the organization, which wanted an untruncated delegation, and the Borah faction, which sought to elect its own pledged delegates.

This means that, while Roosevelt got practically his full party vote as the preferred candidate, Borah got only a little better than half of the total Republican vote.

Now both Roosevelt and Borah actually got a much larger preference vote than the vote cast for delegates in the two primaries. But it is to be remembered that the very important Progressive party of the LaFollette had no delegates as a primary of its own and that, under Wisconsin law, Progressives could vote in either Democratic or Republican primaries.

It is equally reasonable to suppose that they did not vote at all as to preference.
