**Charter Revision**  
**Town Meeting Problem Must Be Solved**  
By RICHARD MARTIN

The principal problem to be decided by the Charter Revision committee will probably be, what to do with the town meeting. Frequently a majority is away by the time the meeting is held. It would be possible to include in the new charter a provision that the total net budget be more than a certain amount without the direct approval of the voters.

The new charter might provide that the voters be authorized to act by appropriations which are not subject to the provisions of the present charter. The voters would be given a chance to vote on a budget of \$400,000, the budget of the year 1936. The voters would automatically receive the amount of jurisdiction over the size of the tax bill. It is likely that the committee will recommend that the town meeting be abolished.

**ETHIOPIA REJECTS MUSSOLINI'S OFFER OF A FORCED PEACE**  
Italy Vows to Take Addis Despite League

Rome, April 17. (AP)—The Italian government today rejected the offer of a forced peace by Benito Mussolini, premier of Italy. The offer, which had been made by the League of Nations, was rejected by the Italian cabinet. The Italian government has vowed to continue its fight for the recovery of Ethiopia.

Genoa, April 17.—The Ethiopian delegation today rejected the modified peace proposals submitted by the League of Nations. The rejection was described as "complete."

Several members of the Committee of 15, arriving for that body's meeting, said that in view of Ethiopia's rejection, there seemed to be nothing to do except declare that the League's efforts had collapsed.

It is the Committee of 15, comprising every member of the committee except Italy, which is expected to meet in Geneva on April 22. The committee will try to bring about a settlement of the war in East Africa.

Early in the day, France had expected to see the Italian government to consent to a cessation of hostilities in order to permit peace negotiations.

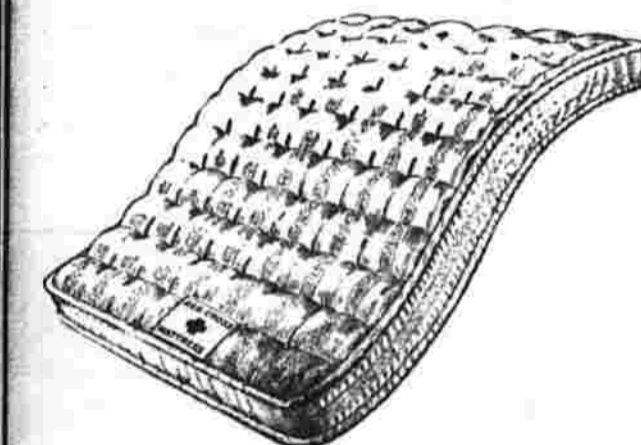

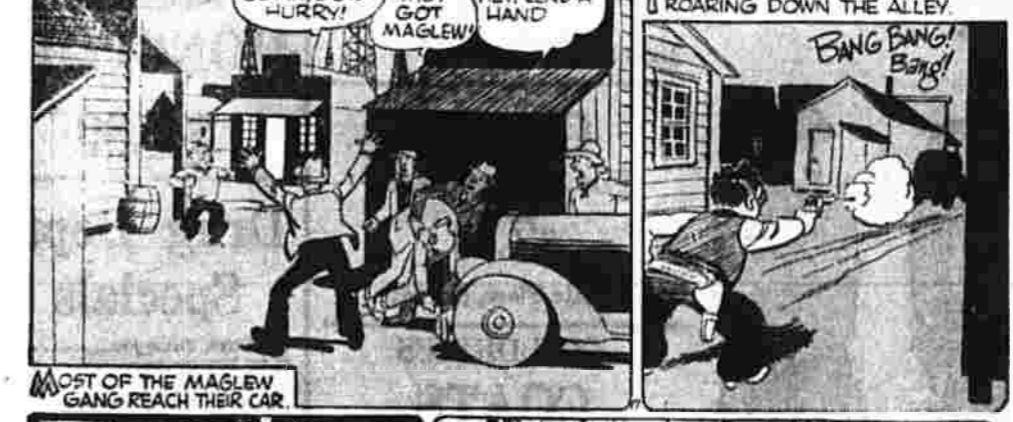

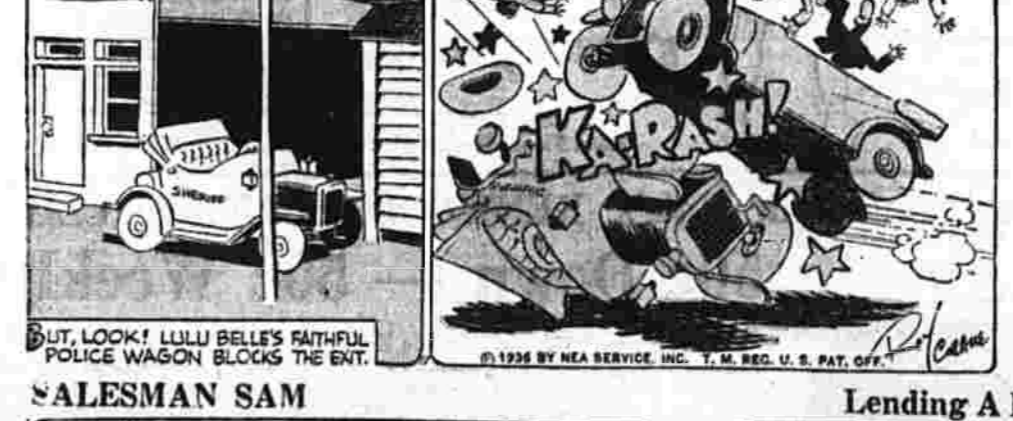
