### CONNECTICUT CO. TELLS WAYS TO AVOID ACCIDENTS

With the motoring season close at hand, officials of the Connecticut Automobile Club have listed eight causes of accidents between motor vehicles and street cars by avoidance of which drivers can easily escape the danger of serious crashing. Seven of the causes may be avoided without difficulty merely by remembering the hazard involved when an easily steered vehicle is placed in the path of a vehicle which is operated on tracks and therefore cannot turn from its path.

Accidents involving trolley cars and motor vehicles have been materially reduced in recent years. It is pointed out, but this type of crash is still the most prevalent in which street cars are involved. First, if any collisions between trolleys and automobiles occur in Connecticut, it is almost invariably at the intersection of a street and a trolley track. ### AN EDITORIAL We Live Better Today

It is interesting to note that, for a few years past, the average American has been living in a more comfortable and more hygienic life than he has ever known before. This is particularly obvious in our homes. The construction of the house itself, the ease with which we can heat, light, and entertain ourselves, the skill and ingenuity of our modern artists, designers, craftsmen and manufacturers, the abundance of modern life which has brought into our homes electric lighting, gas, wide choice of modern appliances, and the ease with which we can obtain better food, are all factors which have made life more comfortable and more enjoyable than it has ever been before.

### GAS PLAYS ROLE OF GUARDIAN OF STATE'S HEALTH

Gas fills an important role in the state health laboratories at Hartford in determining whether or not a disease is communicable. The gas is used in the examination of the laboratory specimens, and the like, to determine if they contain disease-carrying bacteria. Gas is employed in this type of work, being used in all the examinations in the laboratories, those of chemistry and physics, of microbiology, and of serology.

The first named division examines milk, cream, water, ice, sewage, trade wastes, river water, etc., and thermometers and the like. Diagnostic examinations in microbiology determine the presence or absence of the germs of typhoid fever, paratyphoid, diphtheria, tuberculosis, gonorrhea, meningitis, pneumonia, scarlet fever, communicable disease. The division of serology determines the presence or absence of other diseases, chiefly venereal. These processes require some 60,000 cubic feet of gas monthly.

### STATE STATUTES CONTROL FUTURE WATER SUPPLIES

While Connecticut's present public water supplies are more than adequate to meet all the requirements of the State for many years to come, the water supply requirements, taking into consideration increased population and increased industrial demands, which extend as far into the future as the end of the present century, reveal that new sources of supply will have to be brought in by coming generations.

Looking forward with an eye to the future, the fact that the water supplies will be as well protected as they are now is a matter of public interest. The law provides that the State Department of Health shall have authority to require the owners of public water supplies to provide for the protection of the same, and that the department shall have authority to develop and enforce a public water supply law. ### POWER PLANTS BURN HUGE COAL TONNAGE

When there is an increased cost of fuel, it is very interesting to note that the cost of generating electricity, since coal with equipment which turns the turbines and converts their power into electricity, to furnish Connecticut with the 1,274,800 kilowatt hour rate last year, it was necessary for the power and light companies to burn 655,428 tons (2,000 pounds per ton) of coal. In addition, the generating plants also consumed 596,518 barrels of fuel oil. Even a very small increase in the cost of fuel per unit would amount to a considerable item when applied to these figures. Last year there was a definite rise in the cost of fuel at the mines, and this is one of the factors which have caused the increase in the cost of electricity.

Moving about in that fashion, the children have had some rather unusual experiences. In telling about these, they have certainly written an odd book.
