### KANSAS ENDS ITS YEAR WITH A LARGE SURPLUS

State Accountant Reports It

Operating on its avowed "pay-as-you-go" basis, Kansas embarked on a new fiscal year today with a sur-The exact amount of the surplus in the state's general revenue fund had not yet been determined, but A. R. Jones, state accountant, said he expected it to be slightly larger than last year's balance of \$1,007,000.

Likewise, the state's other operating fund—that of fees and special taxes from which the highway and several other departments are financed—will have a surplus, the accountant said.

A year ago today, Kansas officials reported that the state had closed its books on the 1935 fiscal year in the black and a speech was made by Gov. Alf M. Landon, now the Republican Presidential nomines, on "How Kansas Kept Out of the Red."

The state's only debt as such is \$19,250,000 in unmatured soldiers' compensation bonds.

Jones said be expected financial reports of Kansas municipalities—counties, cities, school districts—to show a reduction during the past year in their total bonded indebtedness, which on June 30, 1935, amounted to \$137,141,526.
