any certainty what is going on there. It is, however, in keeping with the probabilities that native forces are making a great deal of trouble for the Italian garrison forces. The reputation of native forces as desperate and persistent fighters was not won in 1936; it had existed for centuries. There were no apparent reasons for believing that they would accept defeat and settle down as subjects of Italy—not, at least, without some years of constant revolt and fighting.

It remains to be seen which can stand the strain of guerrilla warfare the longest, the people whose home Ethiopia is or the distinguished soldiers of It Duca, who are called on to suffer the slings and arrows of an inferior country and a malign climate—for what?

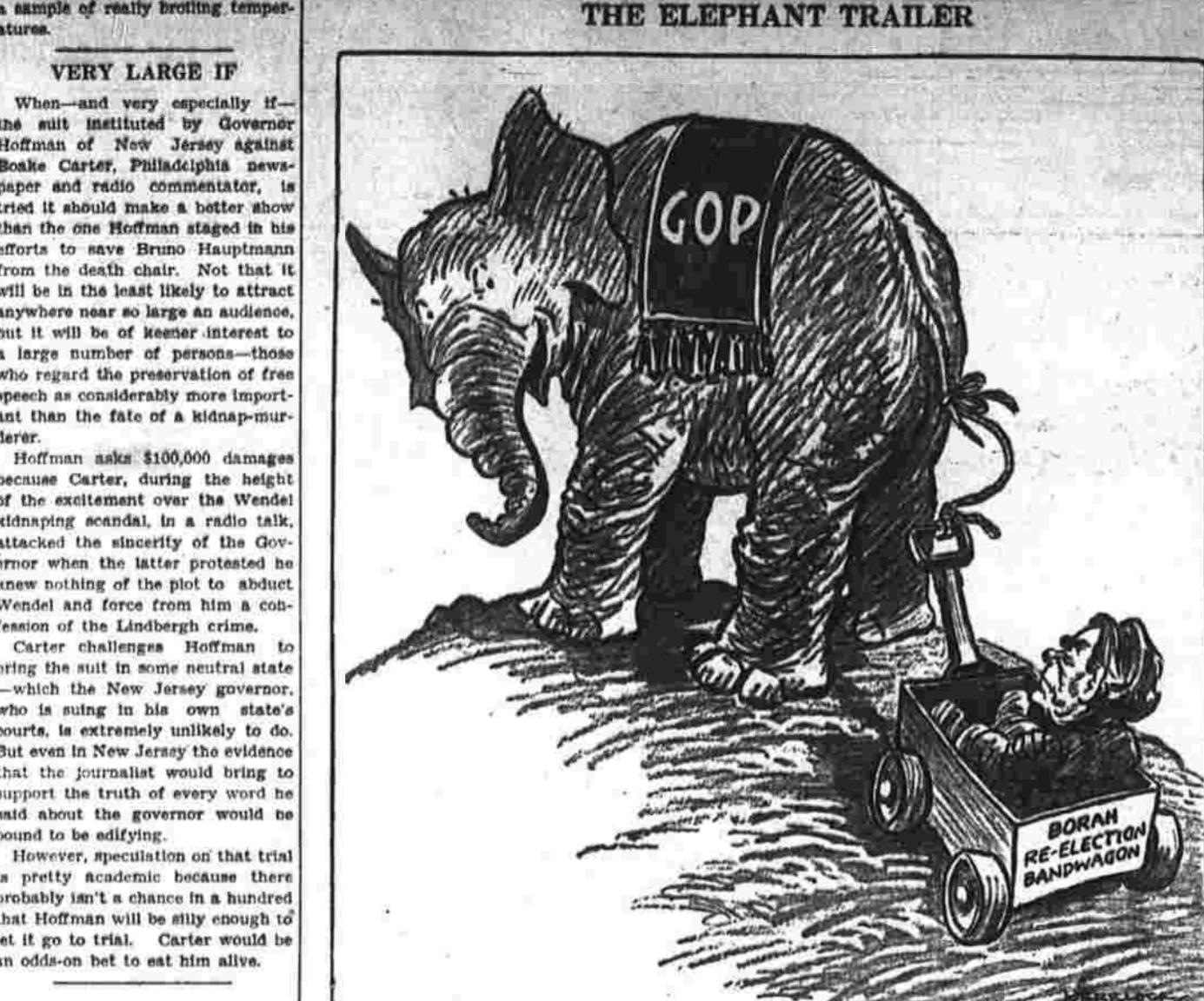

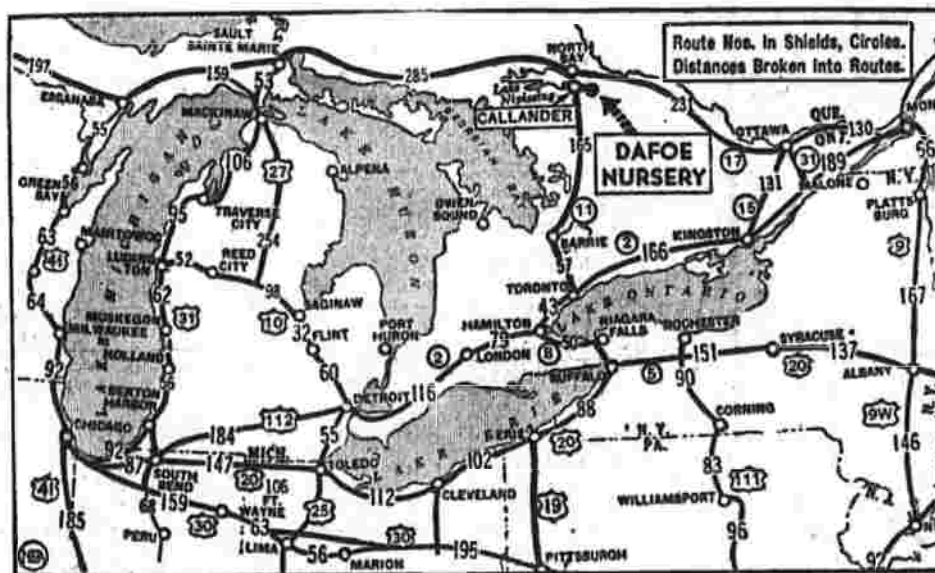
