304 FARM MORTGAGE LOANS IN 3 YEARS

Tolland County Total is \$582,800 President of Federal Land Bank Reports.

Rockville, August 24.—E. H. Thomson, president of the Federal Land Bank of Springfield, Mass., has issued a statement that during the past three years Tolland County farmers have obtained long term mortgage loans of \$282,800. The amount was represented by about 304 loans granted here between May 1935 and July 1, 1936, most of which were made up of the surplus of the previous year.

All of the loans provided for small regular amortization payments in addition to interest. Rates of interest vary from 4 per cent. The balance was on special Commission-er's loans.

Mr. Thomson stated that the "many" do not mean more debts, but do represent a shifting of farm obligations from many scattered creditors to the cooperative land bank system to get the benefit of lower interest rates and more favorable repayment terms.

TOWN'S PER CAPITA DEBT NOW \$116.59

Less Than a Year Ago by \$13.16; May Go Below \$100 This Year.

The per capita share of the town's indebtedness, estimated the municipal auditor, is \$116.59, according to figures in the annual report of Town Treasurer George H. Widdell. The town's total indebtedness is \$2,708,050.

The per person share of the town's indebtedness is less than it was a year ago by \$13.16, assuming the population to be the same for the two dates.

This year, if taxes are adequate, the per capita indebtedness may drop to below \$100.

On the present grand list, the tax on the population could be wiped out with an 80 mill tax, or an eight mill tax on each man, woman and child.

The equivalent of slightly more than nine mills in taxes went this year to reduce the indebtedness by \$13.16 for each man, woman and child.

Other Than Water Bonds

Eliminating the bonded indebtedness of the town, which is expected to be amortized by revenue received for service and will cost, nothing from taxation, the town's total indebtedness would be \$2,708,050.

Without the water debt, the per capita share of the indebtedness is \$93.28. A year ago it was \$106.44. The town's total indebtedness was \$2,708,050.

FAMOUS POLICE CHIEF DIES IN MILWAUKEE

Jacob G. Laubenthal Made His Departure Known All Over Nation For His Efficiency.

Milwaukee, Aug. 24.—(AP)—Chief of Police Jacob G. Laubenthal, the man who made Milwaukee famous as one of the most efficiently policed cities, is dead. He succumbed to a heart attack last night at the age of 62 at the Red Oaks summer resort.

Laubenthal, son of a policeman, was on the force for nearly 44 years and served as chief for the last 15.

He reorganized the entire department in 1924 and the establishment of a police developed a bureau of identification and fingerprinting, a bureau of police records, a police training school in which officers presented such subjects as civics, situation of evidence, typewriting and the department in addition to methods of law enforcement and police statistics.

Laubenthal's manual of department rules and regulations became a guide book for police authorities in many parts of the world, and his reputation for irrefutable facts was widely quoted.

Probably his most widely quoted remark was this: "Police has its place, but not in the police department."
