NELSON TAX CHOICE AS THORNTON, SHEA WIN FOR ASSEMBLY

Insurance and Real Estate Agent Defeats Five Others for Republican Nomination; Legislature Nominates Run Far Ahead of Opponents; Most of Selectmen Re-named.

Samuel Nelson, Jr., of the Holden-Nelson insurance and real estate firm, by a wide margin, was nominated for assembly yesterday by the State Army, defeating five other candidates.

St. Jean de Luz, France, Sept. 8. (AP)—Foreign diplomats accredited to Spain labored today to prevent destruction of the city of San Sebastian, site of many summer embassies.
