SOVIET RENEWS THREAT IN AID OF MADRIDISTS

Makes New Stiff Demand for Action to Isolate War; Asks Quick Consideration of Fresh Proposals.

London, Oct. 14.—(AP)—High Soviet Russian diplomat, pressing a stiff demand for action to isolate the Spanish war, went into communication today with officials of the British Foreign Office.

Soviet Ambassador Ivan M. Malinko and M. Kagan, Russian international non-intervention committee, descended on the British Foreign Office today.

The Russian diplomat, who was accompanied by M. Kagan, said that the new note had been submitted to the Soviet government for its approval.

Ambassador Malinko, it was understood, asked that a full meeting of the committee be called at the earliest possible moment to consider the new document, which was understood to have advanced concrete proposals to halt violation of the non-intervention accord in the future.

"Or else," he said, "the Soviet government will be forced to take the initiative in the non-intervention group."

REICH PUTS UP FORTIFICATIONS ALONG BORDERS

Gun Emplacements Being Erected on Helgoland Island on Western and Northeastern Frontiers.

Berlin, Oct. 14.—(AP)—Bristling lines of concrete fortifications and artillery emplacements are rising around Germany's borders today.

Ten gun bases have been started on Helgoland island off the Schleswig coast while workmen speed construction of other forts along the Baltic coast.

The fortification, the Helgoland harbor, destroyed by the Allies after the World War, is being rebuilt.

Most of the Helgoland defense bases have been located on top of the island's highest point, where large emplacements have been built and guns already moved into place.

Half a dozen smaller gun positions are under construction in other places.

Island tourists are still permitted to explore the old part of the island, but the outer edge of the rock hill defense officials have prohibited visitors from making photographs of the sketches. Armed guards are stationed throughout the island.

Baracks for defense forces have been constructed on the island's largest light-house, being estimated to make way for additional military and naval construction.

The Reichland and Black Forest defense have been described in official reports as the most important military and naval construction.

SEES EUROPE POINTING TO WAR IN TWO YEARS

Dr. John N. Andrews in Lecture Here Last Night Says Feeling of Distrust Is Greater Now Than Just Before the World War.

"Europe can keep the peace, but only two years time will tell if Europe will keep the peace," Dr. John N. Andrews of the education department of New York University told 200 listeners last night during a lecture in the Nathan Hale School auditorium sponsored by the Educational club.

Dr. Andrews spent a large part of last summer conducting a "goodwill tour" through several European countries, with what is being done in European countries.

Dr. Andrews was introduced by Superintendent of Schools Arthur H. Tilley. Before the lecture Miss Polly O'Neal, instructor in Social Security act.

Dr. Andrews told of seeing many soldiers on the streets of Europe, that even Switzerland, Denmark, Sweden and other peace-loving countries are rapidly arming for war.

Spain, he said, is "quite a problem and has created a situation dangerous to all Europe."

The most trouble in Europe, he told the audience, is the struggle between Communism and Fascism for control. The dictators in power have shown no inclination to cooperate with each other but will cause considerable trouble if they do as predicted.

Before the war, he explained, the trend of governments was toward democracy, but since then it has been toward either Fascism or Communism.

The difference of the two forms of government, according to Dr. Andrews is that the Fascists believe in the capitalist form of government while the Communists stand for the complete abolition of private property. In Russia, he said, between 80 and 95 per cent of all property is owned by the government.

Dr. Andrews doubted if the present government in Russia will continue to stand for the increasing unemployment problem.

The Scandinavian countries, which are still democracies, "are moving pretty fast toward the cooperative form of government," the speaker reported. They came through the depression better than any other countries, he said. Successful cooperative apartments have replaced slum areas in Stockholm, Copenhagen and Helsinki, he said.

Telling about the cooperative system in the Scandinavian countries, Dr. Andrews said he did not know if it would work in this country, relating that the president of the World Cooperative Federation, with whom he talked in Finland, told him it had been in question there for 15 to 20 years and that "it would be folly to try

PERFORM AUTOPSY ON HIT-RUN VICTIM

No Reason Given But It Is Thought It Is to Cover Law if Driver Is Caught.

On orders of Dr. H. J. O'Connell, medical examiner of South Windsor, the body of Lawrence Kasarkis, killed early Sunday morning on Burklund road in South Windsor, was taken this morning from the home of William Gedraitis of 73 Eldridge street, and brought to St. Francis hospital, Hartford, where Dr. Henry N. Costello, acting for the county coroner, conducted an autopsy.

Sunday morning when Dr. O'Connell of East Hartford, came South Windsor and viewed the body, he ordered it removed to the home of the driver, William Gedraitis, and gave the chief cause of death as being due to "crushed skull caused on the road about 60 feet south of telephone pole No. 4."

The body was removed from the home of Eldridge street at 9 o'clock this morning by undertaker William P. Quinn and taken to Hartford, where it will continue through Saturday night.

The Scandinavian countries, which are still democracies, "are moving pretty fast toward the cooperative form of government," the speaker reported.

Telling about the cooperative system in the Scandinavian countries, Dr. Andrews said he did not know if it would work in this country.

Dr. Andrews told of seeing many soldiers on the streets of Europe, that even Switzerland, Denmark, Sweden and other peace-loving countries are rapidly arming for war.

Before the war, he explained, the trend of governments was toward democracy, but since then it has been toward either Fascism or Communism.


