SOME TOWN MEN GET PAY RAISE Those in Lower Brackets Increased to 45 Cents Per Hour This Week.

The pay received yesterday by town employees receiving the lowest wages included, for the first time, the raise voted by the selectmen. The raise, which became effective for the week ending last Saturday, increases the minimum hourly wage from 40 to 45 cents except for employees doing garbage collecting and sewage disposal plant work, most of whom receive less than 50 cents an hour.
