FLOOD OF WAGE BOOSTS FLOWS OVER COUNTRY

Warehouse Workers Win a Chicago Strike but Most Advances Are Voluntary On Part of Employers.

Chicago, Nov. 14.—(AP)—To a fresh flood of increasing wages in various parts of the nation was added today a wage boost of seven and a half cents an hour to warehousemen on the West Side.

Their strike against Sam Francisco and Oakland grocery wholesalers was ended last night with an agreement whereby their pay was raised from 62 1/2 cents to 70 cents an hour.

The announcement came in the wake of dozens of other wage revisions in compensation of workers employed by firms representing a cross-section of American business and industry.
