

7. Wage Earner Cautioned Against Losing Card. What Assurance Has John Smith That His Account Will Not Be Claimed By Another John Smith? count Will Not Be Claimed By Another John Smith?

The wage earner who applies for a Social Security account is cautioned not to lose the account identification eard which he will receive through the same channel by which he filed his application. Benefits at 65 will be based on wage credits on his Social Security account, but lose of his account card is not irreparable; he can get another.

The procedure which makes this assurance possible follows: The worker answers the few simple questions as to name and address, date and place of birth, and father's and mother's full names, signs his application and sends it to his local postoffice by one of five ways, none of which requires postage. The local postoffice sends the application to a "typing center." The typing centers are the 1072 first-class postoffices. There the following things are done:

(1) The initial Social Security Board office record and a duplicate are made.
