Reading And Writing
By John Selby

Probably there are some barbed shafts in "Swinnerton: An Autobiography," but being unacquainted directly with the British literary world, these have passed me by. What I got out of the book (foolishly laid aside when it first came because of an "injured" hand of literary people being lit) was the impression of a dandy and sunny nature at large in a land which takes itself a little too seriously. There is, for example, something

rather nauseous about Wells and Bennett and Swinnerton, fitting deliberately to their corner of the Reform Club smoking room, there to sparkle and twinkle. It is like that horrid circumlocution which a certain female American weather bureau uses and turns on at will.

Just the same, a lot of amusing anecdotes were heard in that corner. Swinnerton comes as near to being a happy man as we are likely to find. He was predestined for letters, and he was helping Dent the publisher at 20 or 21 years. His first novel was published when he was 24, and it was with his second that the friendship with Bennett began.

Wells and Bennett were, in a sense, the power behind the Swinnerton throne. Wells secretly wrote a preface for the American edition

of "Nocturna" and Bennett contributed a personal sketch of Swinnerton. They delighted in doing things of that sort for Swinnerton, which proved something about the latter. Incidentally, it brings the reader up short when the author declares that he doesn't think much of "Nocturna," upon which his reputation in this country is built.

The American lecture tour of the charming Mr. Swinnerton is frankly a bore, excepting for occasional slips such as speaking of the headmaster of Yassart House as the headmaster of Yassart House, while writing of his contemporary, such as J. D. Beveridge and E. M. Forster. He draws his punches a little more than an outsider likes. Yet he can be very frank without being very offensive. This frankness extends to himself. Read my time last summer hauling up the passage, too long to quote here,

in which he estimates the effect of the early poverty on himself. "Swinnerton: An Autobiography," by Frank Swinnerton (Doubleday, Doris).

Dinner—Veal loaf, buttered vegetables (carrots, beets and turnips); salad of cooked cabbage and parsley; apple sauce.
Tuesday:
Breakfast—Glass of grapefruit;

thirty minutes before breakfast; well brewed tea; crisp bacon.
Lunch—Potato soup; cooked carrots; lettuce salad.
Dinner—Celery soup; asparagus salad; roast pork; buttered beets; baked apple a la mode.
Wednesday:
Breakfast—Cottage cheese; sliced pineapple.
Lunch—Cooked o. rots and peas; stuffed celery; glass of milk.
Dinner—Baked mutton chops; baked parsnips; lettuce; carrot and asparagus salad; baked pears.
Thursday:
Breakfast—Poached egg on Melba toast; sliced figs.

Am not in the habit of running to doctors but I don't believe either one I have consulted really understands my case."
Answer: Both doctors might be right and you may have both gall bladder trouble and nervousness. On one hand, the dull pain in the lower part of the back might be due to indigestion or to any number of other disorders. Judging from the information given, you have not yet received a complete examination. It is the next step. Much as I would like to help you, it would be ridiculous for me to attempt a guess at the cause of your symptoms.

The only treatment which will help you must be directed to removal of the cause of your distress and before that cause can be removed it must first be found through a thorough examination.
(Intermittent Claudication)
Question: V. L. S. inquires: "Will you give me some information about the condition called, intermittent claudication?"
Answer: Intermittent claudication is used to describe a special condition in which there is no pain while the legs are at rest, but in which pain appears soon after the patient starts to walk. The pain disappears after resting. The usual cause is hardening of the arteries, which interferes with the blood circulation through the legs. The distress over-exercised may be so extreme that the patient finds it impossible to walk very far.
Egg and Tomato Diet
Question: E. P. asks: "Kindly tell me, whether or not the combination of eggs and tomatoes in the preparation of one egg to one-quarter of a large tomato forms a chemical reaction which reduces fat."
Answer: There is nothing about the chemical combination of eggs and tomatoes which will tend to reduce weight. If this diet is used exclusively it will cause reduction because it does not contain much caloric value.
