Farmers in several countries have conducted a "redoubt" against the church taxes—taxes imposed on crosses centuries ago—with the result that they are to be abolished gradually.

Rejection of the revised prayer book strengthened the feeling in some sections of the church itself in favor of disestablishment.

Since there is no longer hope of the church embracing the entire population, power to decide questions and appoint bishops would be given to the laity.

The head of the church himself, then the Archbishop of York, called a special meeting of the church to consider possible courses of action.

The Bishop of Durham flatly came out in opposition to the prayer book.

The Archbishop has been silent on the question since, but some church leaders feel the loss of the church would be more than compensated for by increased devotion to the church's membership if it were put on a purely voluntary basis.
