CHINESE ARMY STOPS TALKING; TO FORCE RELEASE OF CHANG

Government Calls for Quick Military Action in Face of Reports That Rebellion Is Spreading.

Nanking, Dec. 21.—(AP)—China called for swift military action to rescue Generalissimo Chiang Kai-shek in the face of reports that the Chinese rebellion had spread to mountainous Kansu province.

Generalissimo Chiang Kai-shek, chairman of the National Revolutionary Government, stated a sudden coup at the provincial capital, Lanzhou, was confirmed reports reaching Shanghai, and, based in favor of Marshal Chang Hwei-sheng.

Troops of General Yu, former headquarter of the National Revolutionary Government, are reported to have moved into the city of Lanzhou, the exact nature of which are not yet known.

STORM HITS EAST, HOLDS UP TRAFFIC

Rivers in Maine Near the Flood Stage; Boats Hours Late in Arriving.

Boston, Dec. 21.—(AP)—A south-easterly storm left flooded coasts, broken wires, fallen trees and fast moving streams as evidence of its strength today.

Passengers on a New York-Providence and Fall River boat were put off at New London, Conn., and two other boats were hours late in arriving at Providence.

The flow of the Androscoggin River, Me., rose to 10,000 cubic feet per second, near French point, and Central Maine power house employees said they expected it would go higher.

OVER 200 LIVES ARE LOST IN SAN SALVADOR QUAKE

That Many Bodies Recovered in First Few Hours After Temblor; Fear Many More Are Dead.
