NAMITE IS USED BY GANGSTERS TO EXECUTE SQUEALER

Also Marked for Death Escapes After She Is Shot—Blast Felt for Fifty Miles Around.

St. Louis, Mo., Jan. 1.—(AP)—A weird tale of a gangland execution by five and a half tons of high explosive sent police on an intensive hunt today for three former associates who they said blew one of their gang to death and tried to kill his woman companion to prevent them from "working" about a robbery.

Helen Keller, 35, St. Louis City, suffering from eight bullet wounds, told St. Louis Attorney Louis N. Crill of the strange slaying and identified the victim of the blast as Harold Baker, a member of a band which had just staged a \$37,000 robbery of a jewelry store in St. Louis City, Mo.

Baker, she told Crill, was beaten and then left in an explosive automobile five miles east of here last night while three members of the gang fired a fuse and fled after watching her down when she tried to escape across the snow-covered fields.

More than a ton and a half of powder-ripped loose in the explosion that followed. Crill said in more than a dozen business homes were destroyed by the resulting concussion as felt for 50 miles around. Stated panic momentarily seized New Year's revelers.

Marked for Death
Crill said Baker had been to die with Baker in the city before the explosion occurred. He managed to get to a roadside ditch just before the blast. Passing motorists took her to a hospital here.

PIUS XI IS AGAIN RACKED BY PAIN AFTER GOOD DAY

Pope, However, Is Confident of Recovery; Doctors Not So Hopeful; Worried by Heart Condition.

Vatican City, Jan. 1.—(AP)—The piercing pain which has troubled Pope Pius returned late today after the pontiff had spent most of New Year's in an improved condition. The Pope, it was stated, again was suffering from a varicose condition in his left leg. However, the spirits of the 70-year-old Holy Father, seriously ill for nearly a month, brightened with hope for his recovery and the possibility he might again turn to administration of church affairs.

His doctors, although cheered by the pontiff's progress, were cautious in their optimism. They pointed out that periods of comparative strength for patients suffering from the Pope's complications of circulatory, respiratory and cardiac ailments sometimes turn abruptly into a relapse.

Sleeps All Night
The Holy Father slept virtually all night for the first time in weeks. Awakened early, he listened to mass said by his secretaries. Except for his physician, his only visitor was Eugenio Cardinal Pacelli, papal secretary of state.

JOY, WAR THREATS MINGLE AS WORLD HAILS A NEW YEAR

Europe Greet 1937 With Hopes for Peace

London, Jan. 1.—A motif of fear was buried under joyous hope today as Europe greeted 1937.

Diplomatic circles saw the possibility of definite achievement of the strict non-intervention in the Spanish civil war for which they labored so fruitfully in 1936.

Indications from Rome and Berlin led them to believe that Europe's two great Fascist powers would give priority to the problem of foreign volunteers in the peninsula.

Other countries already have expressed adherence in principle to the new Franco-British "hands off" demands.

Romans face the New Year with an army of 1,000,000 men ready for the call to arms but despite the tension, jubilant Romans paved the city's ancient streets with broken glass and crockery in a celebration almost as old as Rome itself.

For days old household utensils have been gathered in piles and at the last stroke of midnight's twelve they were hurled from house windows to the avenues below in a symbolic shattering of old things to make way for the new.

Armed men in Spain were not so hopeful of what the year held in store as they ate their dinner grapes in memory of the dying year which has seen their sunny land devastated by a war between brothers.

Parisians pronounced their "revillon" the gayest since 1929 in a celebration lasting until long after dawn over Montmartre.

The French Parliament, striving with an armament-swollen budget, let the clock swing its hands past midnight instead of halting it to confide deliberations to the old year.

Food rationing—the first since the dark days of the World War—dawned for Germany. More stringent regulations for breadmaking and eating, exchange operations and using war materials as well as tribute and land taxes for each family became the law at midnight.

Chancellor Adolf Hitler declared Germany "could be made independent economically during the next four years."

Berliners, however, had their night of celebration. Bands paraded at dawn through crowded streets. London's population crowded the streets listening to bells, whistles and songs. Many watched the cricket scores from Australia where the English were playing a test match in the heat of a summer afternoon.

The London celebration was brought to a rather abrupt and shabby close at midnight when transportation facilities were stopped.

Over 23 Million Workers Registered Under the New Security Act.

More than 33,000,000 workers in business and industry hereoforth will find one per cent of their \$3,000 in wages deducted by the employer for payment to the Treasury.

HARTFORDITE HELD ON MURDER CHARGE

Mrs. Roberts, arrested by Policemen George Hermes and William Bedford who responded to a radio call, readily admitted the shooting, they reported.

Came From Vermont
Roberts, who came to Hartford from Springfield, Vermont, seven weeks ago to work at the machine shop, moved his wife and four of his six children to Hartford, December 19, the other two remaining with relatives in Vermont. Twice married, he had three children by each of his wives. Chingio, a contractor, came to Hartford from Norwich where his wife and eight children reside.

Mrs. Chingio arranged to come to Hartford today to claim the body. The quarrel between Roberts and Chingio started yesterday afternoon when Chingio complained of the use of electricity by the Roberts family, the juice passing through a common meter in the Chingio cellar.

In court today Roberts was calm and without a stir. In his conversation with the police he appeared cool and collected, smoking a cigarette before his case was

ASSEMBLY CONTROL COMPROMISE NEAR

Both Party Leaders Hopeful Committees Will Be Divided Equally.

Hartford, Jan. 1.—(AP)—The controversy between Democrats and Republicans over control of the joint committees of the 1937 General Assembly may end in a compromise before the legislators convene, Wednesday.

Leaders of both parties, it was learned today, are hopeful of an agreement which will divide the 16 places on the committees equally between the two groups.

This program, which may or may not be acceptable, has achieved an "embryonic" state, at least, as a result of an understanding between J. Francis Smith, Democratic state chairman and J. Henry Roebuck, Republican leader. This was reached Tuesday shortly after Democratic leaders conferred with Governor Green.

The Compromise
Under the discussed compromise, Democrats would get the chairmanships of all committees and two of the three Senate places on each committee. The 12 House places would go to the Democrats and seven Republican, resulting in an 8 to 5 division between the two parties.

If this plan fails, separate organization of both Houses is predicted, with each House functioning
