SIGN OF SPRING EDUCATORS TO ATTEND spring was the announcement by Highway Commissioner John A. Macdonald today of a group of ten new highway projects upon which he will receive bids in a contract let-

he will receive bids in a contract letting to be held Monday. March 15. It will be the highway department's first contract letting since shortly before Christmas. Highway construction operations, except for grading and drainage work, must be suspended during the winter months, even though the weather is abnormally mild.

Included among the ten jobs announced by the commissioner are four projects on the Merritt Parkway on Mew Canaan, Norwalk and Stamford. These call for the construction of two rigid frame construction of two rigid frame construction of two rigid frame construction of a timber pile frestle bridge at the Silvermine River on the drive on the Rudolph Mayer property near the parkway in

trestle bridge at the Silvermine River on the drive on the Rudolph Mayer property near the parkway in Norwalk; and slightly more than one quarter of a mile of grading on the parkway to revise the present grade just west of Guinea Road in Stamford. The bridge jobs also include gravel surfacing work. These are all regular State Projects.

Paving and surfacing provided for in the new contracts will measure 54-5 miles, of which the longest stretch of paving will be about 22-5 miles of waterbound macadam on the Rockville, R. I., road in Voluntown. This is to be done as a State Aid and Town Aid Projects in Bolton entails about two miles of rolled gravel surfacing on Lake and Shoddy Roads. Two federal Public Works Projects call for nearly two-thirds of a mile of bituminous macadam on North Grosvenordale street in Thompson; and a 50-foot T-beam bridge on the Milistone Road at Jordan Cove in Waterford.
