MUNITION SALES AIDED BY STRIKE

Washington, March 5.—(AP)—A munitions firm official told Senate investigators today that labor troubles helped the company's sales in the same respect that a "stipend" would increase a doctor's business.
Committee Chairman LaFollette (Prog-Wisc) introduced correspondence between B. H. Barker, vice president in charge of sales, and company statement which the Senator asserted "indicated labor troubles were used by the company to obtain business growing out of strikes."

Young discounted this, saying most of the increase was due to a better demand for munitions from the Cuban government.
LaFollette said, in the record of his committee, which he said "police departments in small communities can no longer say that they need not worry about trouble."
"Section 7-A of the National Recovery Act states that labor shall have the right to organize without interference on the part of the employer—but it does not state that labor shall not be interfered with by the employer outside. This has thrown open an opportunity for a munitions promoter to come and organize labor for what he can get out of."

LaFollette said the committee had with it records from an investigator of certain industrial "holes" from his files during a previous Senate inquiry.
