Health Education Vital in Getting People to Visit Doctors Soon Enough.

Elaborating on the need for anti-tubercular check-ups by routine health check-ups, the American Tuberculosis Association's health education service, reports as follows:

As proof of the widespread indifference to the health part of the life equation, we have to look at the tuberculosis statistics of this country which report that eight people out of every ten entering their doors as patients in the advanced stages of the disease—a situation that could never occur if people really valued their health. And what a pity it is too, when any tuberculosis specialist at the cost of a few dollars can detect the disease, a patient suffering from tuberculosis can almost surely recover his health.
