**VAN DEVENTER'S EXIT**

Some days ago, when rumor began to deal with probable resignation from the United States Supreme Court bench and the names of Justice Van Deventer and Justice Brandeis were linked as being likely to retire, we expressed the belief that the retirement of Justice Brandeis might take place without greatly disturbing the existing court situation, since it would only result in one liberal succeeding another, but that if Justice Van Deventer were to withdraw from the court it might seriously affect the status of the tribunal as such a resignation might mean the displacement of a conservative by a liberal—which in turn might completely alter the complexion of the court.

**AIR RACE BAN**

**After 90 Years**

At 6 o'clock this afternoon, daylight time, the Fall River boat train will leave Boston and an hour and a half later it will arrive at its destination on the Fall River coast for the first time in its history. 
