 tion had had a weakening effect

 him to possess a peculiar genius for
 leadership and depended on him, for
 many years, to guide it to success.
 This is a fact that should never
 be forgotten, in justice to the mem-
 ory of a great political general.
 Rohrback, as head of his party in
 Connecticut, was the reverse leader
 of a loyal and expert staff of a
