American's avior and the poor man's hope. Wild yells of approval met the President's demand that Congress pass a law establishing minimum wages and maximum hours for industries engaged in interstate commerce.

Now Mr. Roosevelt's hour-vestiges bill before a joint committee of Congress. The industries are against it. Business is against it. John L. Lewis is against it and would be out against it too if Lewis hadn't beaten him in it.

Apparently the only real friend of the bill is the President. Perhaps the industries and business would be against the bill anyway, though that is by no means certain; but labor would assuredly be hot for it if it were the kind of bill Mr. Roosevelt talked about so valiantly once upon a time.

It is so bad a bill that it will almost undoubtedly be dynamited—and should be. It is, however, Mr. Roosevelt's idea of running things in this country.

The President appears to be constitutionally opposed to doing anything whatever in a direct, straight-forward way. He sets up, amid bands and acrobatics, an ostensible objective for which he loudly applauds. Then, instead of setting out toward it in a straight line, he goes on to the right, or the left, or makes a hairpin turn back, moves in circles and curves, until he has created a maze of circumlocution out of which he never gets, and the objective remains, after an enormous amount of fussing, unattained.

No wonder that part of his followers who followed because they believed in his professed objectives are beginning to lose faith and to wonder if the kind of President they ought to have isn't one who would once in a while make a candid frontal attack instead of constantly trying to fool the enemy into letting him sneak around and win the object through the back door and always getting lost on the way.

It is to be determined whether the provisions made in the Manchester bills have in all cases been drawn in the wisest way—whether we have created commissions or boards unnecessarily larger than they might have been; whether we have gone the best possible way about getting welfare operations concentrated into expert hands; as remarked above, we have done the right thing in the legislature—it has already passed the House and is expected to pass the Senate—while having a sound check on the creation of a Board of Finance.

Of course this is on the assumption that the charter amendments authorized by the Legislature will receive the support of the voters of the town in the referendum through which they will either be validated or rejected. It is altogether unlikely that the people of Manchester will block definite progress in the efficient organization of their municipal government, even though the progress be less than some of them may have hoped for.

For our own part we labor under no delusion that even with the ratification of these changes Manchester will have a perfect government. It will still continue to be a greater division of authority and responsibility than we could wish to see. There will still be more of party politics than there ought to be; there will still be too many tag ends.
